

**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 405.05(4)**

**AN ORDINANCE DEALING WITH PAYMENT PROCEDURES AND  
WATER SERVICE SHUT OFF IN THE CITY OF WHEATON**

Findings.

1. The City of Wheaton currently has an Ordinance which provides, in part, for procedures to shut off water service to a property for failure to timely pay the monthly bill for water, sewer, and sanitary service.
2. The existing Ordinance does not contain an exception for when the last day to make a payment before getting water services shut off falls on a Friday, when City Hall is only open for half a day.
3. It is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Wheaton to extend the water shut off deadline that falls on a Friday to the next available business day that City Hall is open.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEATON ORDAINS:**

That Ordinance No. 405.05(4) of the Code of Ordinance for the City of Wheaton is hereby amended to add a paragraph that shall read as follows:

- “D. In the event that the seventh day occurs on a Friday, the deadline to shut off the water supply to the premises shall automatically be extended to the next business day that City Hall is open.”
