Demolition slips must be completed and brought with you on Clean-up Day. No material will be accepted without the appropriate documentation.

- **MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRINGS WILL HAVE A \$20.00 CHARGE EACH AND PAYMENT IS DUE ONSITE.**
- Residential materials only; no contractors.
- Please be prepared to provide proof of Wheaton City residency, with a current driver's license or utility bill. You must have a current utility account, not just a property.
- Materials may be brought to the Demolition Site (East End of Falk Park) on Clean-Up Day.
- **NO GARBAGE WILL BE ACCEPTED. Plastic Items are considered garbage. All items must be sorted prior to unloading. Any items brought that are not on the list, you will have to go home and remove them and come back.**
- **NO BRUSH OR TREES ALLOWED ON CLEAN UP DAY.**
- **YOU MUST UNLOAD YOUR ITEMS. PUBLIC WORKS WILL NOT BE UNLOADING YOUR ITEMS!!!!** Make arrangements prior to clean up day if you need to bring someone with to help unload.
- You **MUST** bring this form with you at the time of drop off.

****This will be coinciding with Traverse County Electronics Clean up day. All county residents may bring their electronics during this time frame.**
