

All India Board for education & training is a private Education board which is legalised further in pursuit of the letter no. 1236 date 29.06.2009 issued by the office of the Deputy Registrar General, Department of excise, prohibition and Registration, Govt. of India, Patna. The issue of such letter is in response of R.T.I. asked by Prakash Kumar, Advocate, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi. By this letter the Deputy Registrar General confirm autonomy of work for DACSSS-Bihar (Dr. Ambedkar Chintan Samajik Sodh Sansthan, Bihar) within the frame work its memorandum and rules and regulations approved by registration in the year 2001 under S.R. Act 21, 1860 by the Govt. of Bihar. Thus, the establishment and functioning of All India Board for Education and Training (AIBET) is justified and validated by said letter No. 1236. Dated 29.06.2009. But council of Boards of school Education (COBSE) denied its membership to AIBET (Acronym) on the ground of being it private/autonomous Board. In this concern para 2 of the MHRD letter no. F.2-35/2011 school 3 dated 24 April, 2017 reads ? COBSE is

trying to build such an image as if COBSE is an autonomous body under MHRD. In fact, MHRD approved autonomous bodies are CBSE, CTSA, KVS, NCERT, NIOS, NVSS, & NBB but not COBSE.

In this respect, COBSE status further may be remarkable in view to the MHRD (Department of School education & Literacy) Notification F.2-35/2011- school. 3 dated 24th April, 2017. MHRD declares ? It is pertinent to note that COBSE is private organization and its membership of COBSE does not automatically grant the status of recognized Board upon any member board.







"The matter has been considered in consultation with National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) which is an autonomous body of MHRD. NIOS has informed that the Rajasthan SOS, Jaipur and APOSS are recognised Boards of secondary and senior secondary education. As regards validity of their certificates for employment purposes, NIOS has informed that concerned APOSS and Rajasthan SOS, Jaipur and its members and their courses/certificates are valid for further studies and appointment in the Central and State Government Departments."

2. It has come to notice that Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE) has been functioning without any authorisation from MHRD using the name of Ministry and trying to build such an image as if COBSE is an autonomous body under MHRD. COBSE claims that it grants membership to the Boards which are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or by Executive order of Central/State Government. These bodies don't require any kind of membership of COBSE.

3. COBSE also claims that it is responsible for verifying genuineness/recognition of School Education Board in India. However, It is pertinent to note that COBSE is a private organisation and its membership is voluntary and COBSE has not been established by this Ministry. 2. Ministry of Human Resource Development had granted recognition to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and national Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS). The State Boards are set up by an Act of State Legislature or by an executive order of the State Government and are responsible to the respective State

3. The matter has been consulted with National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) which is an autonomous body of MHRD and Concil of Boards of School Education in india (COBSE), an Association of national and State School Education Boards. NIOS has informed that the Rajasthan SOS, Jaipur and APOSS are recognized Boards of secondary and senior secondary education As regards Validity of their certificates for employment purposes. it may be got certified form the respective State Open Schools. (COBSE is responsible for verifying genuiness/recognition of School Education Boards in India). It grants membership to Boards/Institutes that are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or an executive order of the Central/ State Governments and follow the national Curriculum Framework, 2005 (NFC-2005) . The certificates issued by Its member Boards are equivalent to any other board across the country. It has informed that APOSS and Rajasthan SOS,Jaipur, are its member and their Courses are recognized

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Recognition of certificates/qualifications awarded by State Open Schools (SOS) for the purpose of employment in Central Government Offices.

Please refer to MHRD O.M. of even no. dated 7th September, 2012 (Copy enclosed) on the subject mentioned above. Para 3 of the said O.M. is withdrawn/cancelled and is substituted as under:

"The matter has been considered in consultation with National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) which is an autonomous body of MHRD. NIOS has informed that the Rajasthan SOS, Jaipur and APOSS are recognised Boards of secondary and senior secondary education. As regards validity of their certificates for employment purposes, NIOS has informed that concerned APOSS and Rajasthan SOS, Jaipur and its members and their courses/certificates are valid for further studies and appointment in the Central and State Government Departments."

2. It has come to notice that Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE) has been functioning without any authorisation from MHRD using the name of Ministry and trying to build such an image as if COBSE is an autonomous body under MHRD. COBSE claims that it grants membership to the Boards which are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or by Executive order of Central/State Government. These bodies don't require any kind of membership of COBSE.

3. COBSE also claims that it is responsible for verifying genuineness/recognition of Schools Education Board in India. However, it is pertinent to note that COBSE is a private organisation and its membership is voluntary and COBSE has not been established by this Ministry. Moreover, membership of COBSE does not automatically grant the status of recognised Board upon any member Board.

Please refer to your RTI applications dated 25.08.2020, received in this Section on 10.09.2020, seeking information under RTI Act -2005. The point wise information is given below:

2. All parts of the question is in the nature of queries and therefore do not constitute information under Section 2(f) of RTI Act, 2005, the CPIO is mandated to provide information held by him in material form. The CPIO is not supposed either to create information or to answer the questions asked by the applicant or to satisfy the queries raised.

3. However, Education falls under entry 25 of the Concurrent List of 7th Schedule of the Constitution of India, hence, both the Central and State Governments have powers to make Act, Rules, Regulations, instructions, etc. to regulate setting up of Education Boards within their respective area of jurisdiction. All the States and Union Territories thus ought to have their own set of Act, Rules, Regulations, instructions to regulate setting up/recognition of Education Boards to conduct public examination and issue of certificates within the territorial jurisdiction. Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE) is a private organization and it has not been established by this Ministry. As the, Membership of COBSE is voluntary, therefore, COBSE is not authorized to give recognition/permission/membership to any education Board.
