

Royal Charter is a formal grant issued by the sovereign on the advice of the Privy Council which are still used to establish significant organization such as learned societies and universities.

UK validation in education and businesses is gained through authorization from Royal Charter or by an act of Parliament or is acting on behalf of an institution authorized.

The first Royal Charter in England was issued in the 13th Century to The University of Cambridge since then 900 charters have been granted by a Monarch. Originally the purpose of a charter was to create and define the Privileges and purpose of a public or private corporation. Chartered status is considered as a mark of professional competency and is awarded mainly by chartered professional bodies and learned societies, common in Britain, it is also used in Ireland, the United States and the commonwealth and has been adopted by **Organisation Around the World.**
