- 3 End the non-stop wars for Empire. No worker should be sent to kill or be killed for capitalist greed. Build a world based on solidarity, cooperation and self-determination.

This is not a pipe dream. This is achievable.

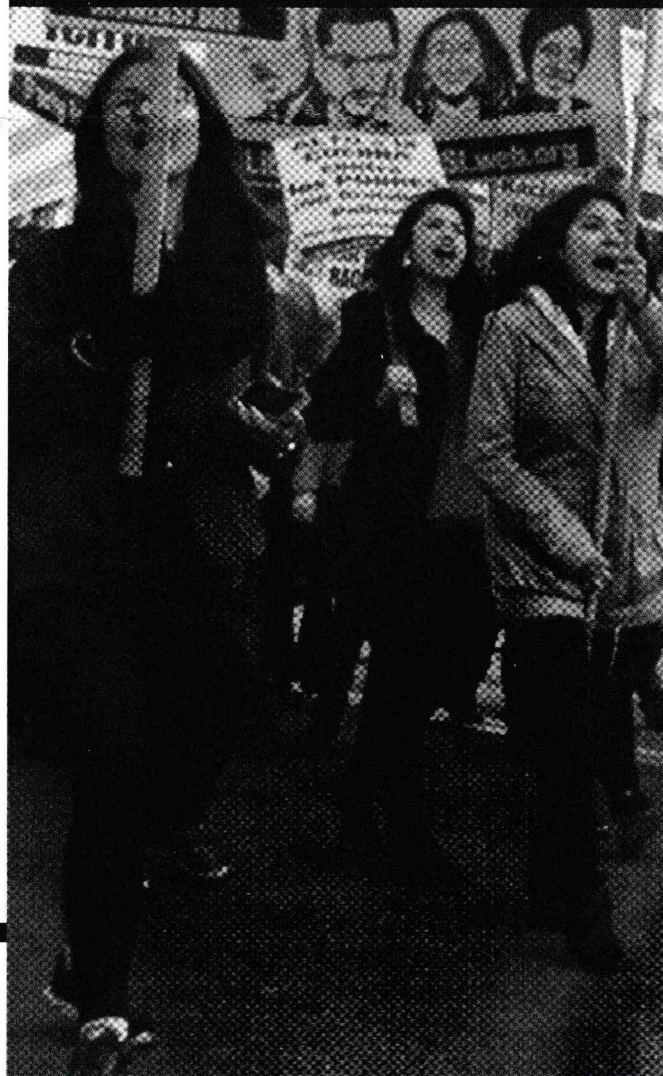
