Major Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Responsible for preliminary patient history or gather the baseline data regarding the patient, including the nature of the Chief complaint, medication list, family history, and medical history.
2. Transcription of patient information into the medical records.
3. Obtains vital signs, record pain scale and functional outcomes etc. and prepares patient for examination.
4. Coordinating in-house referrals to the appropriate department as directed.
5. Coordinating outside patient referrals to the referral coordinator as directed.
6. Responsible for ordering supplies and stocking supplies for the chiropractic department.
7. The Chiropractic Technician may be delegated physiological therapeutics. If they are certified to carryout based on their training certificates.
8. Sets up examination room and cleaning of rooms for the next patient for infection control purposes.
9. Work as a team player to deliver high quality, compassionate care to our patients.
10. Assists with patient education as directed.
11. Maintain certification and educational requirement for the position and provide them to the Director of Chiropractic Services and Human Resources Director.
12. Charts concisely, descriptively, and legibly.
13. Addresses all patient and coworker contacts in a customer friendly and professional manner.
14. Identify problems as it relates to their job and present it to the Chiropractic Director with any recommendations.
15. Skill in exercising a high degree of initiative.
16. Skill in establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with patients, staff and the public.
