The Family Self-Sufficiency Program is a five -year voluntary program designed to assist Public Housing and Section 8 residents in achieving economic independence.

What Are The Benefits of The FSS Program?

As an FSS participant you will establish short and long term goals to help:

- •Increase your income
- •Complete your educational goals
- •Establish or repair credit
- •Establish a savings plan
- •Improve your financial well-being Once the FSS contract (COP) is successfully completed, you receive all the money in the savings account plus any interest. This is called your escrow account.

The FSS program is the only HUD-funded program that directly enables families to save money, and it is effective in helping families accumulate assets.

Who Is Eligible?

To participate, you must be 18 years old or older, be the head of household and a family living in Public Housing or hold a Housing Choice (Section 8) Voucher with Albany Housing Authority.
