Spanning over 200 locations in 74 countries (2021), Hard Rock has become a truly global phenomenon. From its first cafe in London, England which opened in 1971, to properties around the world, Hard Rock International continues to offer great American food in a rock 'n' roll environment. In 1982 Hard Rock opened the first cafe in Los Angeles, California. In 1983 Hard Rock expanded to Asia with its first cafe in Tokyo.

Every Hard Rock Café offers a unique experience, from specific memorabilia that pays tribute to emerging and legendary musicians rooted in each area, to authentic, collectible merchandise that reflects the spirit of the city.

Hard Rock Cafe, London. Where it all started.



Visited by millions of guests each year, Hard Rock Cafe offers high quality American fare and great service in an energetic music atmosphere. There are some Hard Rock Café's which did not belong to the Rank Group or HRC International. Most of them opened before the Rank Group took over the Hard Rock name. It is unknown how many are open at this time or how many have closed. There are probably a dozen or so out there, some which are listed in this book under renegade cafe's.

Hard Rock International is the world's original curator of music memorabilia with the most far-reaching and world's greatest collection. Celebrating new and legendary music icons, the collection is showcased at Hard Rock Cafes, Hard Rock Live venues and Hard Rock Hotels and Casinos around the world. A fulltime staff oversees all aspects of the Hard Rock collection, from the initial procurement of an artifact to its maiden installation at a Hard Rock location. Among the pieces in the collection are photos, guitars and other instruments, clothing and costumes, platinum and gold LPs, posters and album art, and other rare music artifacts.

The story of the birth of Hard Rock's memorabilia collection is itself a part of music history. The collection started with a Eric Clapton guitar, a Fender Lead II. It was the beginning of something that nobody even knew was beginning.

It was just a joke among friends.

Back in the seventies, Clapton, the founder of Cream and Derek & the Dominoes, creator of the immortal "Layla", liked to eat at this quirky American diner in London called the Hard Rock Cafe. The place was this funky old building that used to be a Rolls Royce dealership, and it was run by a couple of young Americans who liked to keep it loose. Founded by Isaac Tigrett and Peter Morton, two enterprising and music-loving Americans, Hard Rock Cafe was an instant classic. You could be yourself at the Hard Rock. It was good food and a good time.

So Clapton got to be friends with the proprietors and asked them to save him a regular table, put up a brass plaque or something. And the young proprietors said, "Why don't we put up your guitar?" They all had a chuckle, and he handed over a guitar, and they slapped it on the wall.

No one thought much more about it. Until a week later, when another guitar arrived, a Gibson Les Paul. With it was a note from Pete Townshend of The Who which read: "Mine's as good as his. Love, Pete." The young proprietors put it on the wall. After that, the guitars never stopped coming.

In 1986 Hard Rock started its memorabilia collection by purchasing Sotheby's memorabilia collection. In 2015 Hard Rock purchased the Elvis Presley gold piano making it the 80,000th piece of music memorabilia in their collection. Today there are more than 80,000 guitars, drums, pianos, harmonicas, microphones, shirts, pants, scarves, shoes, handwritten lyrics, cars, bikes, a bus and assorted rock memorabilia - by far, the largest, most valuable such collection in the world - on the walls of over 200 locations in 74 countries around the world.


Only 50% of the memorabilia is donated while the rest is purchased from auctions or collections.


Some stars ask for a charity donation for the stuff. Others, particularly younger bands, prefer cash. Hard Rock won't take just any instrument or leopard skin cape. To qualify as memorabilia, items must have been used in commercial recording, live on stage or while writing a song.

In 1996 the Hard Rock brand is consolidated into the Rank Group bringing the cafe's and hotels under one roof. In 2007 the Seminole Tribe of Florida buys the Hard Rock International brand for \$965 million.



The guitar that started it all.






Legendary artist Alan Aldridge created the original Hard Rock Cafe logo. From there one of the most notable logos on the planet was born.



Isaac Tigrett and Peter Morton borrowed money from their parents to open a quirky restaurant. They were only 22 years old at the time, and they selected Park Lane in London's fashionable Mayfair district as the site of their 'Hard Rock Cafe.' The decor and menu contrasted sharply with the lavish hotels lining posh Park Lane, where strictly enforced dress codes were the norm, and hamburgers, milk shakes, and the music of the Rolling Stones most certainly were not.

She started serving since the Hard Rock opened on June 14, 1971 and continues to this day as an international ambassador. She has flown all over the world – from Africa and the Middle East to Australia – and has opened more than 100 Hard Rocks around the world.


The Hard Rock Cafe Frankfurt for instance, was the second Hard Rock Cafe after London when it opened in February 1978. Like other Hard Rock Cafe’s in the world, they did not belong to the official chain.

These were some of the allegedly unofficial hard Rock Cafe’s: Amsterdam, closed in 1999, Athens, Ayia Napa Cyprus, Mombassa, Moscow, Mykonos, Paros, Protaras Cyprus, Rhodes Greece, Bochum, Chiang Mai, Formentera, Gran Canaria, Istanbul, Johannesburg, all closed in 2003. Frankfurt closed in 2007 and Sao Paulo is also closed. Many have turned into official cafe’s.

Other than the logo and merchandise, they have nothing else in common with the Hard Rock chain.
