THE TRIP

'Welcome to Guyana, and our Jaguar Explorer Camp'



Our Jaguar Explorer Camp just gets better and better, with two new locations located on the banks of the Upper Essequibo, both providing the best in sport fishing within the region.

Our twin camp adventure provides the sport angler with the ultimate in multi-species fishing with the real potential for that 'bucket list' capture. The trip runs between two camps, both on the upper reaches of the river, with each camp providing a differing and unique set of fishing opportunities.

- Downriver for giant Arapaima in the jungle's lakes and lagoons with Redtail, Surubim Cats, Peacock Bass and Payara on the main river,
- *Upriver* for the bigger Cats, more Peacock Bass, Payara and much, much more.

This trip offers so much to see and do, for solo anglers, couples, fishing partners, families (with kids of 9yrs and above), small groups, and even corporate events up to a maximum of twelve anglers at any one time.

Species include:

- Giant Arapaima.
- Catfish species including: Redtails, Piraiba and Jau.
- Catfish species including Flat Whiskered, Driftwood & Surubim.
- Payara (Vampire Fish), Peacock Bass (2 species).
- Pacu (Red & Black), Couti, Bicuda.
- Electric Eels and Stingray.
- Traira (Wolfish), Arowana.
- Piranha (sp), Jacunda.
- Dogfish, Pescada, plus just so much more.

With over three hundred known species within the River Essequibo, the opportunities are endless. Our camp tally currently sits at 47, so there is headroom for you to add more.

THE LOCATION



The River Esseguibo

The Essequibo is the largest river in Guyana, and the largest river between the Orinoco and Amazon. Rising in the Acarai Mountains near the Brazil-Guyana border, the river flows to the north for 630 miles through forest and savanna into the Atlantic Ocean.

On location (time of season dependent), you will experience a diverse and exciting range of fishing landscapes including enticing sand bars, wild rapids, extensive rock gardens, deep catfish holes, tranquil lakes, and secluded lagoons, each of which will provide you with incredible angling and species opportunities, guaranteed to stretch both you and your tackle to the maximum.

OUR CAMPS

Camp one, is our brand new 'lodge', set within the heart of the jungle. Far enough back to avoid the high waters of the rainy season, this superb lodge serves as our base camp. Recently built, the lodge provides accommodation for twelve, with a huge deck, full kitchen / bar, with 24/7 power, showers, WCs, and the vital social area.



Camp two, is our mobile or 'fly camp' which is around 2 hrs downriver from the lodge. This is tented accommodation, but still retains a level of comfort, with shower / WC, mains power, camp kitchen and social area – but remember – it's the jungle and is more rustic than base camp. It is this camp that connects you to the incredible lakes and lagoons, brimming with Arapaima.



Food is local and plentiful. You will have a hearty breakfast, a 'day pack' whilst out fishing, and a wholesome evening meal, and there is always an ample supply of water, soft drinks, and beer, all maintained at a chilled temperature in the on- camp freezers or whilst fishing, in the cooler.

Both camps run a daily laundry service for your clothes and bedding, and whilst out fishing, our staff keep the camp safe and maintained. We have incredibly knowledgeable boat captains / guides who will keep you safe throughout your trip and will help and provide advice on the fishing to ensure you are 'on the spot'.

OUR ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival and transfer from Cheddi Jagan (GEO) International Airport (or Ogle) to Kanuku Suites and overnight.

Day 2: Early morning departure flight to jungle village airstrip. Boat transfer from village to Camp One. Fishing ½ day pm.

Days 3-5: 3 full days fishing.

Day 6: early am de-camp and travel by boat to Camp Two. Fish ½ day pm.

Days 7-9: 3 further full days fishing.

Day 10: Early flight back to OGLE Airport, transfer to Kanuku Suites and overnight.

Day 11: transfer to GEO or Ogle and onwards journey home.

Included:

- All transfers from Georgetown to the camp and return.
- Two nights at 'Kanuku Suites' (One either side of the trip) including continental breakfast.
- Seven full days fishing and eight nights at camp.
- Three full meals a day, snacks, beer, and soft drinks.
- Daily laundry.

Not Included:

- International Flights.
- Meals and drinks whilst not at camp.
- Additional hotel stays, hard liquor, wine etc.
- Fishing tackle, rods, reels, lures, jigs etc.
- Local airstrip fees US\$30.00
- Tips (We insist on US\$150.00 pp, to be divided equally between the guides and the camp staff).
- Costs associated with any medical advice, consultations, or medication.
- Additional 'night fishing' activities TBA with your host.

Trip Cost pp: Message us for full US\$ pricing and details of any applicable deals / promotions.

Terms and conditions of payments:

50% deposit on reservation with the remaining 50% due 90 days before trip start date.
