THE TRIP

'If you've never caught an Arapaima from within its natural habitat, or if you are a big fan of huge Catfish, then this trip ticks all the boxes'.

Our 'Arapaima Paradise Lodge' fishing adventure offers solo anglers, couples, fishing partners, groups, and families (with kids of 12yrs and above) the chance to catch wild, giant Amazon river monsters, endemic to Bolivia's virgin waters. We have over 100 lakes and lagoons, filled to the brim with massive Arapaima in a private Haçienda (working brazil nut farm / estate) located within in an Indian reservation, covering thousands of acres within Bolivia's Amazon jungle.

'Whilst undertaking the original exploratory for this trip, we also found many large and deep 'holes' containing some of the biggest 'Jau' Catfish we have ever seen'.

THE LOCATION









Bolivia is a landlocked country located in western-central South America. The capital is 'Sucre' and it's main (official) language is Spanish. Situated within the Amazon Basin, it is bordered to the north and east by Brazil, to the southeast by Paraguay, to the south by Argentina, to the southwest by Chile, and to the northwest by Peru.

Bolivia can be divided into three physiographic regions: The **Andean Region**, The **Sub-Andean Region** and the **Llanos Region**, accounting respectively for 28%, 13% and 59% of its national territory.

Bolivia is a land of many waters and has three main drainage basins: Amazon Basin, Río de la Plata Basin, and the Central Basin. The land is punctuated by a wealth of rivers, lakes, and lagoons.

THE LODGE

The Arapaima Paradise Lodge is within a privately-owned Haçienda accommodating up to a max of 8 anglers at an exceptional level of comfort. The lodge itself is built to high standards with four twin rooms, with en-suite bathroom and shower and air conditioning. There is a bar, communal/eating area, TV room/lounge and a main kitchen, providing anglers with a superb selection of local and American style churrascos, and main meals.



Cold beers, local spirits/liquor and soft drinks/water, all meals at the lodge, daily laundry etc are all included in the package, along with transfers on arrival and one night in hotel in Santa Cruz, Bolivia.

Also included are the return national flights from Santa Cruz onto Riberalta and private flight onwards to the Haçienda.

We will have a large, comfortable boat for transfers to the lagoons along the river each morning, and anglers will fish from local canoes made especially for Arapaima fishing that will be in the lagoons waiting and ready.

There will also be boats geared up especially for Catfishing and each boat will have a guide, who will have exceptional watercraft and local knowledge to help put you 'on the spot' and assist with the management of these large and powerful fish.

THE ITINERARY

Day 1: TOUR STARTS. Arrive at the Santa Cruz International Airport in Bolivia, transfer to hotel and overnight.

Day 2: Early morning transfer to airport, commercial flight to Riberalta, then charter flight in same plane to the Haçienda. Overnight at the lodge for next 7 nights (all included).

Day 3-8: Six (6) days guided fishing, overnights at the lodge.

Day 9: Return to Riberalta and onwards to Santa Cruz arriving late afternoon. Onwards journey home – TOUR ENDS.

Note: We can reserve hotel rooms if needed for the return date (cost of room not included).

Included:

- One night at hotel in Santa Cruz (1st day of arrival).
- All transfers from Santa Cruz to the Haçienda and return.
- All local fees (where applicable).
- Six full days fishing and seven nights at the lodge.
- Three full meals a day, snacks, beer, local spirits/liquor, and soft drinks whilst based at the lodge.
- Daily laundry.

Not included:

- International Flights.
- Additional hotel stays.
- Meals and drinks whilst not at the lodge.
- Fishing tackle, lures, jigs etc.
- Tips (suggested US\$250 pp, to be divided equally between the guides and the camp staff).
- Costs associated with any medical advice, consultation, or medications.

Terms and conditions of payments:


50% as deposit on reservation with the remaining 50% due 90 days before trip start date.
