OUR TRIP

'Incredible Peacock Bass fishing in Brazil's Amazon rainforest – The Rio Negro and Rio Branco tributaries'

Amazon-Angler's all-new Fly-in Cabaçairas Cabin Trips in Brazil's Amazon Rainforest is **THE** trip for Peacock Bass fanatics and newbies alike.

Peacock Bass anglers will tell you that once you have had a big Peacock blow up on your surface lure, you'll be hooked for life! There is nothing more exciting than seeing that big fish explode on your prop-bait, spook or other surface bait. The strike is nothing less than awe-inspiring, loud, aggressive, fast, furious and shocking all in one.

There are 15 known species of Peacocks/Tucunare, but our three main target species here are the Giant Three Barred/Speckled Cichla temensis which are the largest at over 30lbs, Butterfly Cichla orienocensis to 14lbs and 'Popoca' Cichla monoculos to 9lbs.

We also catch many other species that hit lures intended for Peacock Bass, and like all great sportfish each has its place in our fishing agenda. Most can be caught on the usual Peacock Bass lures, but many anglers like the variety that these great fish give, so will often bring a few different lures in the tackle box to target them.

THE LOCATION



The Rio Negro River is a major tributary of the Amazon. It originates in several headstreams, including the Vaupés (Mapés) and the Guainía, which rise in the rain forest of eastern Colombia. The Negro meanders generally east-southeastward, picking up the Branco River and other tributaries, to Manaus. Its length is about 1,400 miles (2,250 km), of which 850 miles (1,370 km) are in Brazil. It is navigable for about 450 miles (725 km) above its mouth. Although settlement along its banks is sparse, the river is a major transportation artery.

CAMP LIFE

Our cabin camp is 'one-of-a-kind' and has been set out to very high standards in every sense. Each of the cabins has been built on a double-pontoon system 20ft long x 13ft wide with a draft of less than 10", even when loaded with anglers and gear. Each accommodates two anglers comfortably, with large twin beds, individual air conditioning and en-suite bathroom with a hot-water shower, sink and toilet. There is ample wardrobe storage and hanging space for clothes, luggage and private items.

We also have a large 26ft x 13ft floating restaurant/cabin for chilling, cocktails and eating. There is a fully-stocked bar and fridges in the dining room. A generator supplies 110v power to all rooms and an ice machine provide a 24/7 supply for the ice chests and all drinks. The fully-equipped kitchen is in the support boat and is strictly the domain of our resident cook! The support boat will tow the bungalows in a 'train' fashion to new waters each day.

TRIP ITINERARY

Day 1: TOUR STARTS - arrival in Manaus, Brazil. Transfer Eduardo Gomes International Airport to Hotel and overnight stay in Manaus.

Day 2: Early transfer from Hotel to Local Airport for floatplane or charter flight to the camp or jungle airstrip. Set up gear to go fishing after an early lunch.

Days 3-8: A further six full days of guided fishing.

Day 9: Fly back to Manaus with an expected arrival time before lunch, transfer to Eduardo Gomes International Airport for flight home – TOUR ENDS.

Included:

- All transfers on arrival day before trip and overnight at hotel in Manaus,
- Return flight into jungle,
- All food and beverages whilst at the cabins,
- Daily laundry,
- 6+ days fishing,

Not included:

- International Flights,
- Visas (European, American, Canadian, Australian and Japanese citizens do NOT require a visa for entry into Brazil),
- Meals and drinks while in Manaus,
- Any tips, hard liquor, wine, fishing tackle, rods, reels, lures, jigs etc.
- Costs associated with any medical advice, consultation or medications.

Prices provided shall be in US\$, which may be subject to currency and seasonal variations in relation to the Brazilian Real. Please enquire for exact prices for the dates you are interested in
