"All About Feathers"



STEAM Explanation - Turkey Facts:

- Turkeys make various sounds, including "purrs" and "yelps."
- Wild turkeys can fly up to 55 mph in short bursts.
- Wild turkeys sleep in trees. They fly up to the tree to protect themselves from predators because they can't see well at night.
- Turkey's heads can change color. You can tell a turkey's emotion by the color of their heads. The more intense the colors are, the more intense their emotions.

Materials:

- Playdough or modeling clay
- Googly eyes
- Toothpicks
- Beads
- Feathers
- · Corn Kernals or pumpkin seeds
- Pipe cleaners
- Foam paper for the gobbler
- Scissors



STEAM Activity:

Step 1: Use playdough or clay to create a body shape for the turkey.

Step 2: Cut out a triangle for the beak and gobbler using foam pieces.

Step 3: Add the feathers using toothpicks, feathers, beads, etc.

Step 4: Use the remaining materials for feet, arms, etc.

Step 5: Encourage your child to be creative and design their turkey however they want.

Step 6: Name your turkey and show it to family and friends. Share a few facts about turkeys with your loved ones.
