With over 150 publications and four books released, he is a leading voice when it comes to transit-oriented development as well as resilient transportation. He also holds a Visiting Research Associate position at the University of Oxford's Transport Studies Unit.

Dr. Renne, Professor of Urban and Regional Planning, has also co-founded several companies that promote real estate investments in walkable communities. As an advocate for sustainable communities, he currently works as an advisor to housing developers, including community land trusts.

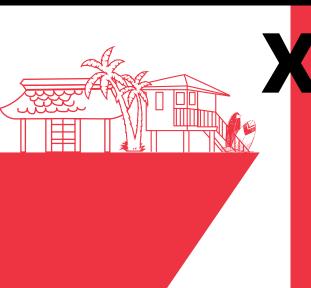
Ata Sarajedini

Ata Sarajedini is currently the Björn Lamborn Endowed Chair in Astrophysics at Florida Atlantic University. He joined FAU in January of 2017 to serve as the Dean of the Charles E. Schmidt College of Science. He received his Ph.D. in Astronomy from Yale University in 1992 and spent five years as a postdoctoral researcher and a Hubble Fellow at Kitt Peak National Observatory near Tucson, Arizona and San Francisco State University. He spent two years at Wesleyan University in Middletown, CT as an Assistant Professor before moving to the University of Florida in 2001.

His research specialty is the study of stellar populations with the goal of understanding how galaxies form and evolve. He received an NSF CAREER award in 2001, a University of Florida Research Professor award in 2006, and was the principal investigator of a large Treasury project with the Hubble Space Telescope in 2014. He has over 500 publications, which have over 16,000 citations and over 200 have appeared in the peer-reviewed literature.

Growing up as an adrenaline junkie, Vanessa Ruck faced a life-changing accident, which lead to a 7-year recovery from bodily injuries, depression, change disorder and fobia of the road. Surprisingly, she then became a rally driver and motorcycle racer.

She has competed in the toughest endurance motorcycle races in the world. Vanessa's fourth race and first international event was Red Bull Romaniacs in 2021, known as the 'toughest motorbike rally'. Transitioning to the desert terrains, she travelled to the Middle East for the 3-day Qatar International Baja race, which involves roadbook navigation - a paper scroll that provides detailed information such as distance, compass bearings, and landmarks, used to guide drivers through the course. After winning the 'Moto Enduro Cup Open Feminin' trophy at Rallye du Maroc in 2021, she became the first women to ever finish the gruelling 8-day Tunisia Desert Challenge. Most recently, inthe Morocco Desert Challenge, a 60% moto attrition rate, she ranked 25th finishing the 8-day battle with the desert.
