The Heat Relief Network is a regional partnership coordinated by the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) in collaboration with municipalities, nonprofit organizations, the faith-based community, and businesses. This network provides hydration stations, refuge locations, and water donation sites throughout the Valley to prevent heat-related illnesses and deaths among vulnerable populations.
