## How to Install your Convert-a-Net



Parts:

- A – Convert-a-Net center strap
- B – 2-Side straps
- C – 45' horizontal strap, with strap adjuster
- D – Measuring tape
- E – Bag

- Run one end (without the strap adjuster) of the horizontal strap through the buckle of the Convert-a-Net strap, be sure to run 2 of the 3 d-rings through the buckle as well. Leave 1 d-ring on the opposite side of the buckle to connect a side strap too.
- Connect the Convert-a-Net strap to the center eye hook on the tennis court and push down on the net to attach the Convert-a-Net over existing center strap.
- Take one end of the horizontal strap and wrap and secure it around the net end post connecting it to your 1st d-ring.
- Loosen the other end of the horizontal strap and wrap and secure it around the opposite end of the center post, using the d-ring. Then pull on the adjuster to tighten.
- Loosen either side strap and connect it to a d-ring about 2' from inside the singles side line and push down on the net to connect the hook to the net cord. Do the same with the other side strap.
- Use your measuring tape to raise or lower the net and adjust your straps as needed.
- Secure the bag on one of the side straps to put your keys or phone in it. This will help avoid forgetting your Convert-a-Net when you are done playing.

Now play, dink, volley, smash and drive. But most of all have FUN!!!
