ATTENDED FUNERALS - funeral director's charges only

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£2395.00
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£975.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£325.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises.	£300.00
Providing a suitable coffin - this will be made from oak veneer	£495.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer).	£000.01
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£300.00

UNATTENDED FUNERALS

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£950.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)²	£1250.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is	£878.00
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal / replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is	£924.00

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for opening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Direct Cremation (Unattended Cremation)

The Direct Cremation Funeral is available for people who do not want a public funeral service

A private cremation will take place with only the Funeral Director in attendance. The highest standards of service and dignified care of the deceased are provided

Direct Cremation costs £1250 including Crematorium Fee.

Payment to be made in full within 2 days of the arrangements being made.

What's included

- Bringing the deceased into our care (within 15 miles)
- Care and preparation
- A simple wood effect coffin
- Attendance of a Funeral Director
- Ashes can be dispersed at the crematorium or returned to our office for collection.

What's not included

- Visiting the deceased
- Choice of where or when the cremation will take place
- Transfer of the deceased beyond 15 miles (additional charges will apply)
- Mourners are not able to attend the crematorium

Modest Funeral

The modest Funeral, a simple choice of public service without a cortege. We still guarantee to provide our usual professional levels of care and service. There will however be no choice of the day and time of the funeral and certain days and times will be excluded.

The cost of a Modest Funeral is £1700 plus third party costs.

Third party fees are services delivered by others, e.g. crematorium fees, that we will manage on your behalf, on average last year our clients paid £1174 in third party fees.

What's included in the Modest Funeral

- Bringing the deceased into our care (within 15 miles)
- Care and preparation
- Wood effect coffin suitable for burial or cremation
- Transportation of the coffin to the crematorium / cemetery for the service
