## FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR CHILDREN



Lori's Voice is a charity that donates to families with special needs children. The requirements for are:

- The child has to be under 21 years old
- The child's disability is a mobility issue, neuromuscular or degenerative disease.
- The family must have a financial need.

UHCCF is an organization that provides grants up to \$5,000 per year and \$10,000 max. per lifetime.

The requirements are:

- The child has to be 16 or younger
- The family income must fall below their assigned threshold.
- The child must have commercial health insurance.

The CSN Fund is given to families with special needs children to assist with purchasing vehicle accessibility devices. The funding can be up to \$10,000 and can be granted twice per family, at least 5 years apart.

- The child must be under the age of 21.
- Enrolled in CSHCS Program

## FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR ADULTS



MRS is state-funded agency that assists individuals with disabilities get and keep a job. They may assist with costs of accessible vehicles. You may be eligible if:

- You attend college or hope to attend college
- You are actively looking for work or you currently have a job.

The VA provides funding for disabled veterans, including wheelchair-accessible vehicles and any adaptive equipment needed.

- For veterans with **100%** service-related disabilities, the VA offers a 1-time automobile allowance to apply to the cost of a chassis. (Up to \$24,115.12) Additionally, the veteran is eligible for up to 2 funded conversions plus adaptive driving equipment every 4 years.

In order to qualify for this benefit, you need to submit:  
**Form 21-4502 Application for Automobile or Other Conveyance and Adaptive Equipment**

- For veterans with **80%** service related disabilities, the VA **MAY** fund an accessible conversion and manual tie-downs once in the veteran's life. This is pending approval through the VA Major Medical and Special Equipment Committee.

## AUTO INSURANCE CATASTROPHIC CLAIMS FUNDING



### Michigan Catastrophic Claims Association

If you are catastrophically injured in an auto accident, you may be eligible for funding for vehicle modifications through your open claim with your insurance company. Your insurance adjuster will coordinate with MCCA to determine your eligibility for vehicle modifications.

## MOBILITY REBATES

When you purchase a **NEW** wheelchair-accessible vehicle, you may be eligible for a mobility rebate through the vehicle manufacturer.

- **GM Rebate (Chevy Traverse)**– Up to \$1,000
- **Toyota**– Up to \$1,000
- **Honda**– Up to \$1,000
- **Chrysler**– Up to \$1,000
- **Additional Manufacturers** (Subaru, Mercedes Benz, etc.)

Ask your Clock Mobility Sales Rep to assist you with submitting the rebate paperwork when you purchase a new vehicle.
