Trash Reminder

Trash receptacles are to be placed at the edge of driveways only on the designated trash day. Once trash has been picked up, these receptacles must be removed from driveways within 24 hours. When not on the street for trash pick-up, all trash receptacles are to be stored in the garage or "out of sight" behind a fence enclosure. All trash must be kept in bins at all times. Bags of trash or other household items being disposed of are never to be left outside bins. Accumulation of garbage and/or building material or of the like constitutes a nuisance.



Please park in the clubhouse parking lot while waiting on the bus with your children. I am having complaints from residents not being able to enter or exit the community with cars parked at the end of Spring Way Square. Holly Springs PD is aware of this and will be doing ride throughs to monitor the parking situation.

Hidden Springs Townhomes is an H.O.A. community, whereas every homeowner is responsible for paying their monthly assessment (dues) of \$95.00 by the first of each month. If assessments are not paid by the $10^{th of}$ each month, a \$10.00 fine will be charged. Some homeowners are under the assumption that their mortgage company is paying the monthly assessment, however mortgage companies DO NOT pay H.O.A. dues. The assessments are used to maintain the community, common areas, and bookkeeping. To keep delinquent assessments at a minimum, we are aggressively pursuing collections through our attorneys, which could result in a judgement being filed against the homeowner, garnishment of wages, or a lien on your home. Attorney fees will be the responsibility of the homeowner. Also, if your account is delinquent, you are restricted access to the pool and tennis courts, and your passkeys will be deactivated. As an H.O.A. community, let's work together and be responsible for keeping our assessments (dues) paid and up to date.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

I have had several complaints from residents and the Landscapers regarding pet owners not picking up after their pets. The landscapers have been informed not to maintain lawns fenced or unfenced if area is not picked up. He will send me details of the homes that he has not serviced because of this.


