**Playing With Dolls: Child's Play and Adults Escape
in the Western World Over Centuries**

We welcome the New Year with an internationally recognized authority on the topic of dolls, **Elizabeth Ann Coleman**. She will reveal in her presentation a historical overview, "Playing With Dolls: Child's Play and Adult's Escape in the Western World Over Centuries". She will lead us on an investigation featuring dolls that are representative of moments in time, as well as the popularity of certain materials for production and the general commonality of dolls; whether created for children, or more recently, adults. Prepare to come away with new knowledge about dolls as well as the artifacts made and generally cherished at some point in your own lives.

Elizabeth Ann Coleman is a self-taught, award winning and internationally recognized former costume and textile curator. Ms Coleman has a working career of over forty years at major north American museums.

Among her varied accomplishments are:

Redressing period rooms, graduate school teaching, authoring publications, consulting and lecturing internationally, innovating exhibitions, and co-founding and governing organizations related to her profession.

Since childhood, dolls have played a major role in her life. This began in a partnership with her late mother and sister, and is carried on to this day as a "rabbit hole" exploration of what dolls can reveal.

A recently approved rule allows new members who join after the first of January to pay a reduced membership fee of \$30 (there is a 2 meeting requirement)



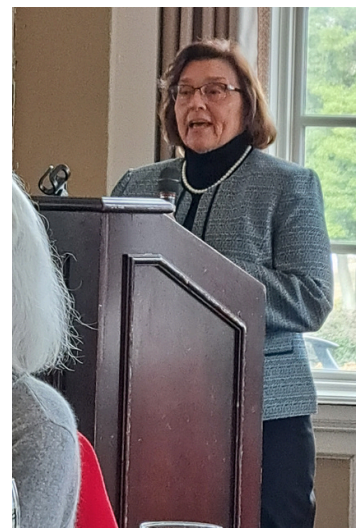
