- proof of address (driver's license, health card, bill, rent receipt)

You can register ONCE for the Christmas Exchange. If you register with RiverCross, you must not register anywhere else.

- 2. No furniture, boxes, or personal items in hallways they attract pests and are a fire hazard.
- 3. Keep food stored properly and keep your unit clean.

Your cooperation matters and is not optional. Let's better everyone's health and safety. If you see signs of rats, mice, or cockroaches report it right away so action can be taken.
