## **CVRC** IS **OPEN!**

**And** we can't wait to see you! Some important changes have been made at the CVRC to protect you and the CVRC staff:

- Our hours to the public are 10:00am 3:00pm, for the time being, but you can call us from 8:30am-4:30pm, Monday to Friday and we will be here for you!
- Everyone will be required to sanitize their hands at the entrance and remain within the designated marked 2-metre rule at the main entrance. You will be given a risk assessment (3 questions) and asked for your name / contact number and the time you came in and left the CVRC will be noted.
- The Saint John Bike Share Program is operating. The Food Purchase Club is back in action and the Clothing Room is available too, but please <u>call us first</u> to arrange a time to visit.
- Faxing and photocopying are still available. If you require additional support or access to other services, we will have a safe and confidential environment for you to chat with one of our staff.

Check our Facebook page often for updates on programs such as Healthy Breakfast and other services. Call us if you have questions. See you soon!

Remember, keep a minimum distance of two metres between yourself and others at all times, with the exception of members of the same household or "bubble". Community face masks must be worn in public when you are unable to maintain physical distancing. Wash your hands often and don't touch your face.

## FLEMMING COURT PLAY PARK AND COVID 19

Parents and guardians: Although Flemming Court play park is open - it is on a "use-at-your-own-risk basis." Users are asked to practice physical distancing, wear masks if this is not possible, use hand sanitizer or wash hands before and after using equipment, and leave the playground once you have finished play to ensure there is no crowding within these areas. ## Ways to prevent spreading germs

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands



Stay home when you are sick



Wash your hands frequently using soap and water for at least 20 seconds and then dry your hands for 20 seconds
