### What is a Healthy Toddler Assessment?



It is an assessment for children 18-24 months, that is done by Public Health Nurses. It is a chance to check on your child's growth and development. It allows for the early detection of any concerns. It will give you the chance to have your child's vaccine records checked by a Public Health Nurse. You can also ask the nurse any

## LOW-INCOME SENIORS' BENEFIT: CV RESOURCE CENTRE CAN HELP YOU APPLY



To qualify for the 2026 annual benefit of \$629 the applicant must have been a resident of New Brunswick on December 31, 2025, and a recipient of a benefit under the Old Age Security Act (Canada), notably:

- The Federal Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) during 2025 (must be 65 years or older) or
- the Federal Allowance for the Survivor during 2025 (must be between 60-64 years old) or
- the Federal Allowance during 2025 (must be between 60-64 years old).

**Important:** Persons in receipt of a federal allowance who are under the age of 60 do not qualify for this benefit. Where both spouses receive the GIS and reside in the same household, only one \$629 benefit will be granted. However, where spouses live separately (for example, one residing in a nursing home), both will be eligible for the benefit.

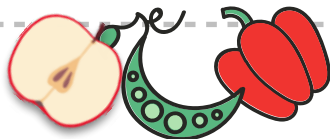

**Friendly Reminder:** Crescent Valley has safe needle disposal boxes located outside of the CVRC building at 130 MacLaren Boulevard.

One is attached to the CVRC building in the driveway across from the Splash Pad and the other is behind the CVRC building by the Bike Repair shed. This allows people to safely dispose of needles they have used or found outside.

**PLEASE**, be very careful if you choose to dispose of a found needle on your own. Do not touch them with your bare hand. If you would rather not dispose of it on your own, you can call 648-4455 and a representative from the City will come and dispose of them.

In the interest of safety, talk to your children, grandchildren, etc., to warn them to stay away from any needles they may find and to immediately tell an adult they trust if they see one.


