BOAT LAUNCH, GATE KEY & STORAGE GUIDELINES:

ANNUAL GATE KEY FEE: \$25.00

Lock change will occur Sunday Just 1st. Purchase and/or pick-up your key at the beach from 9am to 1pm. If you are unable to pick-up in person, a block captain will deliver them to your home. Please turn in your 2022 key to be recycled for reuse.

SEASONAL WATERCRAFT STORAGE: \$25.00. This is available for row boats, canoes, and kayaks. Space is limited and available on a first come-first serve basis. The season for watercraft begins April 1st and ends November 1st. Any unclaimed, abandoned or unregistered watercraft will be removed and disposed of properly and assessed a removal fee. All watercraft stored at LSPIA must remain LOCKED when not in use.

BOAT LAUNCH: When using the boat launch please close & lock the gate after each use. The launching area must be clear at all times - please see diagram in kiosk. Members may allow one guest motorized watercraft per day. Member must be present during launching of guests watercraft and must inform guests of the Village rules of conduct for Bangs Lake. Members will be held responsible for guest conduct on the

- *Return old launch keys with your dues. Additional fine of \$25 will be applied, if old key is not returned!

- *If you find beach towels, goggles, etc left at the beach, leave them in the pavillion to be claimed by their owners.
 - *Please pick up and put away shared toys before you leave the beach.
