





### "CAÑON CITY"

Cañon City, Colorado, home of one of the first Colorado Orange Apples, home of the Territorial Prison, and home of the motion picture industry in Colorado. Silent pictures and westerns were once filmed here in Fremont County. Filmmakers were drawn to the area because of its natural beauty, topography, mild climate. the Arkansas River, the D&RG Railroad, and good light.

Tom Mix, silent film star, was often a guest in Cañon City at the Elks lodge, Hell's Half Acre, and rumored to have spent many a night in the Prospect Heights Jail. Other film stars were seen on the streets through the 20th century including Burt Lancaster, John Wayne, Slim Pickins, Lee Marvin, Charles Bronson, and Goldie Hawn. These were just a few coming here to film a blockbuster. Notable movies included *Stage Coach*, *Cañon City, Vengeance Valley, True Grit, Mr. Majestyk, and Cat Ballou*.

Join us for an afternoon of movie and popcorn as we look back on the 1947 prison break from the Colorado Territorial Prison or otherwise know as "Old Max." *Cañon City*, the movie, was shot just a year after the famous break in the same location. We will see Warden Roy Best playing himself in this epic film.
