REGISTRATION FOR 2018/2019

Registration for Indus Preschool 2018/2019 will be held at Indus Recreation Center on Wednesday, February 28th at 6 p.m. Classes are offered on a first-come-first-served basis. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m. and registration will begin at 6 p.m.

Each child registering needs a form. All questions on the form must be completed, or have an N/A if not applicable to you. The registration fee of \$40/child, first month's tuition, and all postdated cheques for October to June are required at time of registration.

Tuition fees are: \$50 - one-day program, \$100 - two-day program, \$145 - three-day program

Before Indus Preschool can accept any registrations from returning, or new, students, the Executive Board positions must be filled for the year. The Board meets once per month, with varying time commitments depending on the role. We are currently looking for a Vice President, and Secretary.
