All adopters must be able to get a positive vet reference before the adoption.

All adopters agree to a home check before or after the adoption. If the home check is not found to be a safe and healthy environment for the dog then the adopter agrees to let the homecheck team return the dog to the rescue and the full adoption fee will be returned to the adopter within 10 days.

A negative vet reference and or homecheck will null and void the adoption and the dog will be returned to APOH Rescue. If the adoption was processed awaiting a vet reference, and it is not a good reference then the fee minus \$50 will be refunded to the applicant.

All dogs will be microchipped with AKC Reunite to the APOH Rescue for life. The adopter will be listed as a secondary contact. This is to ensure the rescue is contacted if the dog is lost or rehomed against our policy.

If you adopt one of our dogs, you agree **NEVER** to rehome the dog, and to return him/her to APOH Rescue if for any reason you are unable to keep him/ her

If you adopt one of our dogs, do you agree to give APOH Rescue complete access to the dog's records with the veterinarian responsible for the care of the dog?

If adopting an unaltered puppy, the adopter agrees to have the pet spayed/neutered by 6 months of age. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the pet.

If the pet has not been altered within one month of the original surgery appointment you agree to return the dog to APOH Rescue.

Pet will be altered at our veterinarian's office at APOH Rescue's cost or at the adopter's vet at their own cost.

Follow up by APOH Rescue will happen if proof of spay/neuter is not provided.

If for some reason you are not satisfied with your rescue dog, the adoption fee is refundable minus a \$50 fee within the first 10 days. The adoption fee is non-refundable after the 10 day adjustment period.

The adoption fee may be paid by cash, local checks with valid ID, PayPal, credit card or money order. The fee covers the vet care this dog has had up to this point, including vaccinations, spay/neuter and any health issues that were treated for the dog. All dogs have been tested and are heartworm negative OR are being treated at APOH Rescue and are on flea preventative.

By signing here, you agree to continue these treatments for your pet's lifetime.

If your new dog shows signs of illness in the first 3 days we ask that you call 850-503-0469 or 850-232-3338. If it is something that requires a vet visit, we will make you an appointment at our vet and we will cover the cost. If you take the dog to your personal vet we will not be responsible for the vet bill. _____

Adoption fees range from \$250.00 to \$500.00 unless otherwise specified at the time of the adoption. This fee covers the cost of vetting your rescue dog and the cost of running the rescue to continue to save more dogs in the future.

Our dogs are family members.

We only adopt to owners we feel are suitable. Small breeds cannot live outdoors or be left alone for more than a normal work day (8 hours). They may require dental exams yearly along with regular physical exams. If you are approved for adoption, you agree that all veterinary care will be provided as recommended by the veterinarian listed.

IF YOU ARE ADOPTING A DOG THAT IS WAITING FOR A SPAY/NEUTER:

IT IS REQUIRED THAT YOU GET YOUR NEW FAMILY MEMBER TO THE APPOINTMENT.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO MAKE IT TO THE APPOINTMENT YOU MUST GIVE AT LEAST 24 HOURS NOTICE FOR US TO RESCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT. CALL 850-503-0469 TO NOTIFY US. LEAVE A VOICEMAIL IF NO ANSWER.

A MISSED APPOINTMENT WITHOUT NOTICE FORFEITS THE RESCUE PAYING FOR THE SPAY/NEUTER. THEN THE SPAY/NEUTER WILL BE AT THE ADOPTERS EXPENSE AND IS REQUIRED WITHIN ONE MONTH OF THE ORIGINAL DATE OF YOUR MISSED APPOINTMENT OR YOU AGREE TO RETURN THE DOG TO THE RESCUE WITH NO REFUND.

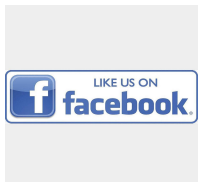
