REQUIREMENTS:

Free Walk Medium Walk Flatwalk 20 meter circle Halt through walk **PURPOSE**: To introduce the rider and/or horse to the sport of dressage. To show understanding of riding the horse forward with a steady tempo into an elastic contact with independent, steady hands and a correctly balanced seat. To show proper geometry of figures in the arena with correct bend (corners and circles)

Medium walk Willing and balanced transition; F-A clear walk rhythm; bending in corner and turn. Down Centerline Straightness on centerline. Α Halt and salute Straightness; willing, balanced 9 Χ transition at halt.


