- \$20 Per Class, Ribbons to 6th place
- *\$5.00 Fun Classes
- \$30 Per Championship Class Ribbons to 6th place, Paybacks 1st \$40, 2nd\$30,3rd\$20 4th \$10 Minimum 3 Horses in Championships for paybacks.
- DQP Fees: \$10 a day per horse
- \$75 stalls (Includes 2 bags of shavings) Additional Shavings can be purchased onsite. \$8.00 per bag payable at entry booth.
- \$35 Tack stall (No shavings)
- \$35 camping per day
- \$15 Showing from the trailer per day (no overnight)

General Rules:

- Michigan Law requires a Negative Coggins for all horses over the age of 6 months.
- Proper Attire Required per NWHA Rules
- No horses allowed in camping areas
- OT means Optional tack English or Western attire
- Youth 11 and under must wear Equestrian Helmet when seated on a horse on the show grounds.
- Novice Horse not to have won 3 blue ribbons in NWHA shows.
- NWHA Rules will be followed visit nwha.com for the current rules
- All scratches/adds must be done (1) one hour prior to class, no refunds.
- Arrivals not allowed before Thursday 2pm
- All entries must be inspected by DQP before each class.

- All 1st Place winners must report to DQP Station immediately following the class.
- Plantation Pleasure (PP) -11/2" x 1/2" max shoe permitted. No cross entries into LS, PLS, TP, CP or ADP divisions.
- Park Lite Shod (PLS) -1" x I/2" max shoe permitted.
 No cross entries into LS,
 TP, CP or ADP divisions.
 May enter PP division.
- Lite Shod (LS) 3/4" x 3/8" max shoe permitted. No cross entries into TP, CP or ADP divisions. May enter PLS or PP divisions.
- Trail Pleasure (TP) -3/4" x 3/8" max shoe permitted.
 No cross entries into any other divisions.
- Country Pleasure Classes (CP) -Keg Shod only. Two handed reining permitted in English or Western tack. No cross entries into PP, PLS, LS or TP. May cross enter into All Day Pleasure.
- All Day Pleasure Classes
 (ADP) are open to all easy
 gaited flat shod horses.
 Two handed reining
 permitted in English or
 Western tack. No cross
 entries into PP, PLS, LS or
 TP. May cross enter into
 Country Pleasure, if keg
 shod. Shoeing in ADP
 classes may be up to a Lite
 Shod shoe (3/4" x 3/8").
- NWHA Show Card or membership required for all ADULTS showing in NWHA regulated (TWH, RH or SSH) classes. Cards are available in the show office for \$20 per show.
- NWHA Show Card or not required for Youth.

- Black Hoof Polish, Pads, bands, plastic wrap and action devices of any kind are prohibited at this show.
- No stallions allowed in any youth designated class.
- For Championship Classes, horse must show in at least one preliminary class in that same division.
- TWHBEA Medallion class has paybacks of \$75 for first, \$50 for second, \$40 for third, \$30 for fourth, and \$20 for fifth) No entry fee. Look here for more information: https://twhbea.com/youthyouth-medallion-program/
