All entries must be completed using Horse Shows Online. Stall and Camper/RV reservations MUST be included with your online entry under either your barn account or horse entry. Entries must be received on or before 9/12/25 to qualify for pre-entry rates. Both Owner and Rider must have current NWHA membership to exhibit at The National. Persons on federal disqualification may not transport horses to show and only may participate as a spectator. No plastic wraps, action devices, full blinders, or hoof bands permitted on show grounds. Each entry MUST present through DQP for inspection prior to being shown.

**Regional Grand Championship Classes** 1<sup>st</sup> Place (\$75), 2<sup>nd</sup> Place (\$50), 3<sup>rd</sup> Place (\$25), 4<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Place (Ribbon). See below for entry requirements.

**Best In Show** Classes 234, 235, 236 will have a \$50 entry fee and 50/50 jackpot payout for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>. See below for entry requirements.

#### **Rules and Regulations**

The below rules and regulations are intended to serve as guidelines for the show. Complete NWHA Rules and Regulations can be found at <a href="https://www.nwha.com">www.nwha.com</a>

#### **Entry Rules**

- Horses are not required to be registered. Horse entry name MUST match horse's name on Coggins. If horse
  is registered, it should be registered under current owner on record.
- ALL horses on show grounds are required to have a current negative Coggins (exception horses 6 months or less). Copy MUST be on file in show office.
- ALL out of state horses must have a current 30-day health certificate
- NWHA Shoeing Regulations can be found in the <u>NWHA Rulebook</u>
- No adds or scratches accepted 1 hour prior to session start time
- Cross-entering between All Day Pleasure and Country Pleasure at The National is not allowed
- Abbreviations: AOT (Amateur Owned and Trained), SSH (Spotted Saddle Horse), RH (Racking Horse)
- Championship and Regional Grand Championship eligibility: Qualifying class requirements/participation
  are the responsibility of the owner/rider/trainer. Should a horse/rider be found ineligible in a Championship
  or Regional Grand Championship due to non-participation or excused for any reason from the appropriate
  qualifying class(es), the entry is considered ineligible. In the case of post-entry ineligibility, the class(es)
  will be re-tied and all related fees are non-refundable.
- Championship Classes: Horse must have shown in qualifying divisional preliminary class to enter. No premiums paid, awards only.
- Regional Grand Championship Classes: Horse must have placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in a qualifying Championship Class (2 gait or 3 gait) at an NWHA Regional Championship Show within their division. Paybacks for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Optional Tack Championship Classes: Western horses will not be required to perform 360 degree turn in the line-up
- Split Classes: Classes will be split at 20 for youth and 26 for adult, amateur, and open classes
- Show results are not considered official until certified by show management. Decisions by show management, DQP, and judges are considered final. Protests may be filed as per the NWHA rulebook.
- Owner/Exhibitor/Horse receiving an HPA violation during The National forfeit all fees and any show premiums won by that entry.
- Novice Horses and Riders
  - Novice Horse (Rail Classes) Horse has not won a blue ribbon in a rail class at any National
  - Novice Horse (Versatility Classes) Horse has not won a blue ribbon in a versatility class at any National
  - o Novice Rider Rider has not won a blue ribbon in any rail class at any National

#### **Best In Show**

- After a horse has won (3) consecutive years in a row, the horse is not permitted for re-entry in that specific Best In Show class.
- Best In Show entries must have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in a Championship class

## AOT (Amateur Owned and Trained) See sections 4.1.8, 6.3, and 7.3 for the complete list of AOT rules and regulations

- Horses on lease are NOT considered AOT and are therefore not permitted to show in AOT designated classes
- AOT horse ownership established by joint ownership, leases, or contracts is prohibited
- AOT classes are open to horses that are owned and trained by an amateur and only may be exhibited by owner and/or amateurs within their immediate family

- A 90 day wait-period must be satisfied after owner transfer, professional training/coaching for either horse or rider
- AOT All Divisions 2 Gait (Class 83): Open to TWH, SSH, RH that are AOT. Gait calls will be First and Second Gait
- AOT All Divisions 3 Gait (Class 120): Open to TWH, SSH, RH that are AOT. Gait calls will be First and Second Gait, and Canter.
- SSH AOT All Divisions 2 Gait (Class 97, 215): Open to all SSH that are AOT. Gait Calls will be Show Walk and Show Gait
- o RH AOT All Divisions 2 Gait (Class 157, 199): Open to all RH that are AOT. Gait Calls will be Trail Walk/Show Walk and Trail Rack/Slow Rack.

#### **Dressage**

- Horses may enter up to (3) Traditional Dressage tests on Saturday and (3) Western Dressage classes on Sunday
- Entries will be limited to 60 tests per day and are first-come first-serve. Entries received after the allotted tests are full will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are received. Ride times will be posted to www.thenwhanational.com.
- Dressage First Level Test of Choice and Western Dressage First Level Test of Choice riders will be able to ride up to (3) classes in this level if they choose this level for their (3) class distribution.

#### **Trail Obstacle**

- Novice (Class 12) Open to any horse/rider combination that has not won a blue ribbon in Trail Obstacle
  classes at any National. Western horses of any age may ride two-handed in an NWHA legal snaffle or shank
  bit in this class ONLY.
- In-Hand (Class 16) Open to any age exhibitor or horse

**Western Riding and Basic Reining (Novice Classes 23, 25)** open to either horse or rider who have never won a blue ribbon in Western Riding or Basic Reining at The National. Riders may ride with two hands in a shank bit and do simple lead changes vs. flying lead changes.

**Equitation:** If more than (4) youth entries in the Adult/Youth, class will be run concurrently and two sets of ribbons will be awarded separately to Adult and Youth exhibitors.

• Intermediate Equitation (77) is a 2-gait class and for Novice Riders only (not to have won a blue ribbon in stock seat or walking seat equitation at any NWHA National) and may cross enter into 3-gait equitation classes (19 and 31).

- Racking Horse: Open Division, Jr. Horse 5 & Under, Regional Grand Championship Trail Pleasure Walk or Show Walk, Trail Pleasure Rack or Slow Rack
- SSH: Open Division, Regional Grand Championship Show Walk, Show Gait
- Double Rider Pleasure Gait, Trail Walk
