



Ambassador High Point Program

The purpose of the NWHHA Ambassador High Point Program is to encourage membership and participation in NWHHA even when there are no NWHHA affiliated shows in an individual's geographic region. Specifically, the program would encompass 4-H shows, High School Team shows and open shows in areas that have no access to NWHHA shows. This program is also offered to Tennessee Walking Horse enthusiasts internationally.

Program Requirements:

- The exhibitor must be an NWHHA member no later than when logbooks are due on December 15. In this program, the points accumulate with the exhibitor rather than the horse. The owner of the horse does not have to be an NWHHA member.
- Many shows will count for points, however, shows that are affiliated with **any** TWH HIO program are not eligible. This restriction includes WHOA, SHOW, SSHBEA, TWHBEA and NWHHA shows.
- An exhibitor cannot earn any awards in the NWHHA Ambassador Program if they showed any horse at any NWHHA Affiliated Show, in that calendar year.
- Points can be earned in all classes, halter, pleasure, and versatility. Classes can be open to all breeds or offered specifically for gaited horses.
- Horses used do not have to be registered Tennessee Walking Horses as specified under NWHHA rules (Rule 4.1.6) but must display walking horse gaits.

We recognize that there are Tennessee Walking Horse owners who do not have access to NWHHA shows in many parts of the world. We also recognize that showing the TWH in open shows is a great way to promote the great gaits, disposition, and versatility of the TWH. Our hope is that NWHHA members in the NWHHA Ambassador Program will feel that they are a part of the NWHHA and may aspire to attend an NWHHA show, help sponsor an NWHHA show or attend the Nationals through this involvement with the NWHHA.
