1. Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> place
2. South Carolina State Law requires a Current Negative Coggins for all out of state horses over 6 months of age.
3. All entries must be inspected by DQP prior to each class, and first place winners must return thru DQP.
4. Only one exhibitor, horse, and rider permitted in inspection area.
5. If a class doesn't specify AOT or Amateur, it is assumed Open.
6. Plantation Pleasure Shoe: 1 1/2" x 1/2" max shoe permitted. No cross entries into LS, PLS, TP, CP or ADP divisions.
7. Park Lite Shod – 1" x 1/2" max shoe permitted. No cross entries into LS, TP, CP or ADP divisions, however cross entry is allowed into PP divisions.
8. Lite Shod – 3/4" x 3/8" max shoe permitted. No cross entries into TP, CP, or ADP divisions, however cross entry into PLS or PP is permitted.
9. Trail Pleasure – 3/4" x 3/8" max shoe permitted. No cross entries into PP, PLS, LS, CP, or ADP divisions.
10. Country Pleasure – Keg shod only, Two handed reining permitted in English or western tack. No cross entries into PP, PLS, LS, or TP, but can cross enter into ADP.
11. All Day Pleasure – are open to any easy gaited flat shod horses, max shoe size is 3/4" x 3/8". Two handed reining is permitted in both English and Western tack. Cannot cross enter into PP, PLS, LS, or TP, but can cross enter into CP if Keg shod!
12. No communication devices allowed in any classes.
13. NWA Show Card or Membership required for all Adult showing in NWA regulated classes. Cards are available in the show office and are \$25 each. NWA Membership can be purchased as well with a separate check for payment. Horse must be owned by NWA member in order to qualify for High Point Program.
14. NWA Show Card or membership is not required for youth classes.

15. Safety Helmets are required for all riders 11&Under.
16. Pads, bands, saran wrap/plastic wrap, and action devices of any kind are prohibited on show grounds. Failure to adhere will be grounds for disqualification.
17. Black hoof polish is permitted at the show.
18. Horses showing in Western All Day Pleasure or Country Pleasure classes are allowed to wear cavessons.
19. No Stallions allowed in youth designated classes.
20. Class entries/Scratches must be made at least 7 classes prior to the class.
21. For Championship Classes, the horse must have shown in one preliminary class in order to qualify.
22. Championship Class entries must be made prior to the start of that session.
23. Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as a spectator.
