

National Walking Horse Association High Point Program

Purpose: To award horses competing at NWHA events annually in specified divisions.

<u>Eligibility Rules:</u> The following rules must be met in order to participate in the annual high point award program.

- Owner must be a current NWHA Member by the last day of the NWHA National Championship Show
- Only NWHA Affiliated/Sanctioned events are eligible.

Points: Points will be awarded in the following manner:

- Awarded per show season December 16th to December 15th
- Points will be awarded to a horse, not to a rider.
- Horses receive the following:
 - Single Points: All NWHA affiliated and sanctioned events
 - o Double Points: All NWHA Regional Championship shows
 - Triple points: The NWHA National Championship Show
- The BOD, office and High Point Committee will see that points are tabulated appropriately by the NWHA office or by someone contracted for that purpose.
 - Points are awarded by the declared placings of awards given as detailed on the show bill as reflected in the official show results.
 - Ties will be broken in the following sequence, should the initial method fail to break the tie, the next method and so on will be used. If all methods are unsuccessful, multiple horses will be awarded.
 - Tie break sequence
 - o The horse that has won the most first places
 - The horse that has shown and placed over the greater amount of horses
 - The horse that has shown the least number of times

End of Year Overall Categories:

The horse that accumulates the most points in each Overall category will be awarded the associated title as outlined below:

- Overall Rail Horse
 - o The sum of all rail points earned, earning a minimum of 120 points in rail classes.
- Overall Versatility Horse
 - Must show in three different categories of Versatility events as listed in the HP chart.
 - o Must accumulate 10 points in each of the three different categories for eligibility
 - o The sum of all versatility points earned
- Overall Horse of the Year

Horse must meet Overall Rail and Versatility Horse requirements for eligibility

- o The sum of all rail points earned
- o The sum of versatility points
