

# Elite Amateur Owned and Trained Program Standard Operating Procedure

**Purpose**: To enhance the Amateur Owned and Trained (AOT) award opportunities within the National Walking Horse Association (NWHA).

**Scope**: This procedure applies to eligible Amateur Owned and Trained exhibitor and NWHA member. (See Rulebook Sections 4.1.8, 6.3, 7.3 for AOT Eligibility).

# **Responsibilities**:

Title	Description
NWHA Office	Receives Elite AOT Program Nomination forms and works with appointed individual responsible for maintaining the points throughout the year. The appointed individual may be the NWHA Office Manager or appointed by the Board of Directors.
Nominee	Individual submitting their nomination to the NWHA Office in order to recognize their eligibility to accumulate points in this program.

#### **Procedures**:

## 1. Eligibility

- a. The Nominee must meet the Amateur Owned and Trained criteria listed in the NWHA Rule Book Sections 4.1.8, 6.3, and 7.3.
- b. Nomination Form must be completed for the horse, rider, owner, and declared division (see schedule and fee details below).
- c. Forms may be mailed or e-mailed (see form for details).
- d. Nomination Fee may be paid via the NWHA Store or check.
- e. Proof of ownership must be provided in the form of registration papers for registered horses or Coggins for unregistered horses.

# 2. Nomination Fee Schedule

- a. Submitted by May 1<sup>st</sup>: \$100
- b. Submitted after May 1<sup>st</sup> but before September 1<sup>st</sup>: \$200
- c. Submitted after September 1<sup>st</sup> but before December 15<sup>th</sup>: \$350 *No nominations will be accepted after December 15<sup>th</sup>*
- d. Horse, rider, and division must be declared when the nomination form is submitted. Points will count from December 16<sup>th</sup> to December 15<sup>th</sup> which is in line with the Year-End High Point SOP.
- e. Nomination fee will be used to payout a year-end jackpot, awards, and to be applied to the NWHA Elite AOT Program.

#### 3. Point Accumulation

## a. Competition:

- Only NWHA affiliated events count for points. Only classes designated as Amateur Owned and Trained on the show bill will count for points in the Elite AOT Program. Points are accumulated as follows:
  - The National (triple points)
  - Regional Show (double points)
  - NWHA Affiliated Event (single point)

Nominees that attend the NWHA National Championship Show that
competes in an AOT preliminary class for their designated division, an
AOT Championship class for their designated division, and the AOT
Best In Show shall receive an additional 30 points in their tally for the
current show season, regardless of placing. Nominee must participate
in all three to acquire the additional 30 points.

# b. Community Outreach:

- In addition to accumulating points by showing, nominees can also gain points through committee involvement or volunteering at an NWHA affiliated event.
  - on an NWHA committee and contribute to that committee. The committee chair must sign off on submitted involvement prior to year-end point submissions. It is the responsibility of the nominee to request committee chair approval and submit supporting documentation to the NWHA Office.
  - All Around Involvement: 10 points Volunteering at an NWHA affiliated event. Two (2) points are accumulated for one (1) hour of volunteer time. Volunteer duties can be assigned by show management as needed. Duties include, but are not limited to, center ring set-up, working the gate, handing out ribbons, pre/post show set-up, and other duties as needed by the show. Nominees can earn a maximum of 10 points at each affiliated show they volunteer at.

# 4. **Division Designation**

- a. Nominees must choose ONE division to declare their designation in this program and are open to both 2 gait and 3 gait classes:
  - All Day Pleasure
  - Country Pleasure
  - Trail Pleasure
  - Lite Shod
  - Park Lite Shod
  - Plantation Pleasure
  - Spotted Saddle Horse
  - Racking Horse
