- Dressage—Horses can enter up to three Classical Dressage and three Western Dressage classes on Sunday.
- Novice Horse Horse has not won a blue ribbon in a rail class at any National. Same applies for versatility novice classes.
- Novice Rider—Rider has not won a blue ribbon in a rail class at any National.
- Youth Riders 17 years and under as of January 1, 2024
- Youth Riders 11 yrs & under must wear approved ASTM safety helmet while mounted at all times, this includes Leadline.
- Intermediate Equitation Classes (84) is a two-gait class and for novice riders only (not to have won a blue ribbon in stock seat or walking seat equitation at The National) and may cross enter into 3 gait equitation classes (24 & 53)
- Dressage: Dressage entries will be limited to 60 tests total. Entries are first come first serve. Pre-entries for dressage will be accepted until 9/16/24. After that, entries will only be accepted as the schedule allows. Dressage entries received after the allotted tests are full will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are received. Ride times will be posted on the Nationals Show Page (thenwhanational.com) after the closing date. Dressage First Level Test of Choice and Western Dressage First Level Test of Choice riders will be able to ride up to three classes in this level if they choose this level for their three class distribution.
- Trail Obstacle, In Hand (Class #24) Open to all horse ages
- Trail Obstacle Novice (Class#20 ONLY) Open to any horse/rider combo that has not won a Blue Ribbon in Trail Obstacle classes at any National. Western horses may ride two handed in an NWHA legal snaffle or shank bit IN THIS CLASS ONLY FOR 2024.
- Classes split 20 for youth only classes / 26 for adult, amateur and open classes
- Qualifying classes for Championships qualifying class requirements/ participation are the responsibility of the owner/trainer/rider. Should a horse/rider be found ineligible in a Championship Class due to non- participation or excused for any reason from the appropriate qualifying class(s), the entry is considered ineligible for said championship. In case of post entry ineligibility, the class(s) shall be re-tied and all related fees are non-refundable.
- Owner/Exhibitor/Horse receiving an HPA violation during The National forfeit all fees and any show premiums won by that entry.
 Show results are not considered official until certified by show management. Decisions by show management, DQP and judges are considered final. Protests may be filed as per the NWHA rulebook.
- All out of state horses present on show grounds must have a current 30 day health certificate.
- All horses on show grounds must have a current negative Coggins (exception horses 6 months or less) Copy must be on file in show office.
- Spotted Saddle Horse, Open Division, Regional Grand Championship—Show Walk, Show Gait
- Racking Horse, Open Division, Regional Grand Championship—Trail Pleasure Walk or Show Walk, Trail Pleasure Rack or Slow Rack
- Racking Horse, Open Division, Junior Horse 5 & Under— Trail Pleasure Walk or Show Walk, Trail Pleasure Rack or Slow Rack
- Optional Tack Championship—Western horses will NOT be required to perform a 360 degree turn in the line up
- All Day Pleasure and Country Pleasure—cross entering is NOT allowed
- AOT All Divisions 2 gait/OT Class Open to TWH, SSH, RH that are AOT. Gait calls will be First Gait and Second Gait.

- AOT All Divisions 3 gait/OT Class Open to TWH, SSH, RH that are AOT. Gait calls will be First Gait, Second Gait, and Canter.
- SSH AOT All Divisions 2g/OT Class Open to all SSH that are AOT. Gait calls will be Show Walk and Show Gait.
- RH AOT All Divisions 2g/OT Class Open to all RH that are AOT. Gait calls will be Trail Walk/Show Walk and Trail Rack/Slow Rack.
- Lead Line and In Hand, Youth Handler -- No stallions allowed, certified helmets required for all riders 11 & under.
- Novice Western Riding and Novice Basic Reining are open to all of those (Horse or Rider) who have never won a Blue Ribbon in Western Riding or Basic Reining at Nationals and riders are allowed to ride with 2 hands in a shank bit and do simple lead changes vs. flying lead changes.
- ****If there are more than 4 youth entries in the Adult/Youth Equitation Classes, the classes will be run concurrently and two sets of ribbons given, one for Youth, and one for Adults.
- Ranch Horse Class will include pattern and rail-work. Open to all gaited breeds. See show website for complete details on Ranch Horse criteria.
- Best In Show—First Gait, Second Gait Open to all exhibitors that place 1st-3rd in ANY Championship class
- Best In Show AOT First Gait, Second Gait Open to all AOT exhibitors that place 1st-3rd in ANY Championship class
- Best in Show Youth First Gait, Second Gait Open to all youth exhibitors that place 1st 3rd in ANY Championship class
- Double rider classes—Pleasure Gait, Trail Walk
- Sanctioned with TWHBEA International High Point Program
- All Around Horse/Rider High Point Program offered by NWHA, see website for details
- NWHA RULES WILL BE USED AND WILL PREVAIL!
- Sanctioned with SSHBEA, HOWEVER, NWHA SPOTTED SADDLE HORSE RULES WILL PREVAIL!
- Horses entered do not have to be registered, but the horse must be registered under its officially
 recorded name or by which it is known. It must also be entered under the name of the owner on
 record.

- The use of leg wraps, including vet wrap, is *prohibited* while in the show ring. Additionally, anchoring a horse's tail to a fixed point (i.e. tail tying) is *prohibited*. Exceptions regarding leg protection are made for versatility events (see section 8.5 Equipment in NWHA Rulebook).
- Hoof bands are *prohibited* on horses on the show grounds.
- The use of communication devices while showing is *prohibited*.
- Toe length shall not exceed 5 inches
- Exhibitors must present their horse to DQP prior to the start of each class. Winner of each class must present back to DQP for post-show inspection
 immediately following the completion of the class.
- Shoeing Guidelines: See NWHA Rulebook Section 9 Shoeing for complete details. The below serves as a guide and not an inclusive list of all shoeing rules.
 - o Plantation Shoe: Measurements: 1.5" Wide, 1/2" Thickness. No more than 1" Turn back
 - o Park Lite Shod Shoe Divisions: Measurements: 1" Wide, 1/2" Thickness. No more than 1" Turn back
 - o Lite Shod Shoe Divisions: Measurements: 3/4" Wide, 3/8" Thickness. No more than 1" Turn back
 - Keg Shoe Divisions: A keg shoe must be a factory-made, non-draft breed, stamped shoe (poured or cast) hot- or cold- rolled steel or aluminum shoe. Only flat or heeled keg shoe options are allowed.
 - The use of borium is permitted on the heel only and defined in section 9 of shoeing guidelines
