B. Vice President: Amanda Culbertson

- 1. Purpose of projects is to meet the needs of the community and we do not need "hands off" projects
- 2. Proposed plans: Special needs, elderly, reinvolvement at liberty park (clean up)
- 3. It may be an idea to pass or release a project into the community for other groups to pick up
- 4. May need to focus on projects helping males, providing camps, etiquette classes
- 5. PIC Results and this will be discussed at Feb chapter meeting... 56 actives and 19 provisionals completed the survey... 41% were first year actives, 21% were 3rd year actives, 16% were 2nd year actives, 15% were 5th year actives and 9% were 4th year actives

- 6. Current Projects Results:
 - a. 35 voted yes and 14 voted no to continue the provisional project next year said the progress was great, presented well... revised once it becomes a chapter project.
 - b. 74% backpacks great, helps kids, is needed... name is too long (create a new name like "Helping Hands")... could it be done at another time in year? We could distribute the backpacks with blessing distribution...
 - c. 70% Blessings organized, successful, biggest this year, liked multiple locations, if so big, maybe form a separate committee, do we need to apply for more grants, does chapter need to give its own money, look into costco/merchants to donate food, possibly done in spring or thanksgiving since others provide at Christmas
 - d. 70% Community Events need more organization
 - e. 60% Crown Club outstanding and organized... NAJA requires Child Welfare component... CC fits this... must remain and keep the committee format
 - f. 48% Hope Totes in limbo over-reaching children outside of Madison County but is beneficial... may be done in early spring or in summer, only 24 bags this year for Madison County... maybe add small suitcase, pillow, blanket
 - g. 44% Bunny Breakfast love it, not enough publicity, ran out of food in past, maybe move from service to finance..
 - h. 42% Sunnybrook rewarding, covid changed a lot, having virtual cooking classes, can be passed on to another group/organization
 - i. 38% Glass Slipper covid changed access, needs to be advertised in community, not just in schools, branch out to include school pageants, can include hair and make up
 - j. 30% Little Libraries love it, need a plan to restock or change books
 - k. 30% Canton Ministries during the week, needs to be revamped, maybe create themes, hold meetings, cooking classes, etiquette classes, skills classes, etc.
 - I. 30% Sirs and Sweethearts keep it because it is the only project for elderly
 - m. 28% Super Safe Sitters maybe add to CM, hard to do with Covid
 - n. 26% Christmas Parade since we only do the cookies part now, combine with Community Events Project... let CC continue doing float submission
 - o. 24% Money for Minds lack of participation from applicants, covid challenged this, the head of M4M should be assistant treasurer.
