WHAT IS BREATHE EASY AT HOME ?

Breathe Easy At Home is a program that bridges the gap in services for tracheostomy and ventilator families, between hospital discharge and home. Upon request of the child's parents, Viktoria's Angels team members will come to the hospital to meet you and your child, get a sense of the child and families' needs, and identify what types of services might be the most helpful. Some of the things we assist with include:

- Preparing for transport home
- Setting up and organizing medical supplies in the home
 - Trouble shooting basic equipment challenges
 - Help with use of medical supplies, that are often different than the hospital supplies
 - Access to our large medical supply surplus
- Guidance in navigating our complex healthcare system
 - Assistance with advocating for your child

Viktoria's Angels is a local non-profit created in memory of Viktoria, an exceptional medically fragile child, who was a vital part of our tight knit community. Her legacy lives on in this organization, which was formed to help bridge the gaps where current resources don't adequately meet families' needs.
