



Honey Bake-Off Entry Rules

General

- No entry fee. Open to all. Recipes need not be original.
- Entry must be covered and set on or inside a disposable container.
- One entry per container.
- Refrigeration is NOT available.
- Contestants limited to one entry per category.
- Entrants' name is not to be anywhere on their item, neither on the container nor recipe form(s). Violating this rule may result in disqualification.
- As a courtesy to other entrants, entries received after official registration or that do not fit into a specified category will be ineligible for judging but would be appreciated as a donation for the bake sale.
- A selection of entries MAY be chosen to be published in the next edition of Taste of Honey (Honeyfest cookbook).
- Entries are the property of the Lithopolis Honeyfest and will be sold by bake sale. All proceeds go toward operating costs of the Lithopolis Honeyfest.

Registration

- Entries must be taken directly to Wagnalls Memorial Library Community Building. Entries will be accepted on Friday, September 8, from 3pm-7pm, and judging will commence promptly at 7pm.
 - Entries will be judged on: 1) use of honey - required amount must be used; 2) flavor - great taste; 3) texture - pleasing and palatable; and 4) appearance - pleasing to look at with a nice presentation.
- Bake sale on Sunday, September 8, will go from 10am until majority of items are sold.
- Awards:
 - 1st place: \$25.00
 - 2nd place: \$15.00
 - 3rd place: \$10.00
 - It is the responsibility of the contestant to pick up their awards when winners are announced at the WAGNALL'S STAGE on Saturday morning at 10:00am. Awards will be mailed to any winners not in attendance.

Categories

- Bar Cookies (minimum quantity - one dozen! Honey is required as 50% of all sweetening agents.)
- Drop and Form Cookies (minimum quantity - one dozen! Honey is required as 50% of all sweetening agents)
- Cakes (minimum quantity - 1 whole cake, or one dozen cupcakes! Honey is required as 50% of all sweetening agents)
- Pies (1 whole pie! Honey is required as 50% of all sweetening agents.)
- Muffins (minimum quantity - 1 dozen / Quick Bread (minimum quantity - 1 whole loaf **non-yeast** Honey is required as 50% of all sweetening agents.)
- Yeast Bread (minimum quantity - 1 loaf or 1 dozen rolls **Requires 100% honey as sole sweetener!)
- Munchies - Unique or imaginative snack using honey, i.e. popcorn, granola, snack mix, etc. **Honey must be 50% of all sweeteners.**
- Gluten-free
