Parent Safety Guide: Roblox

With more young children exploring online games like **Roblox**, **Minecraft**, and **Fortnite**, it's more important than ever for parents to understand these platforms — and how to help keep kids safe while they play.

Many of the children I work with regularly mention these games as part of their daily routines and social lives. While they can be creative, educational, and fun, they also expose children to potential risks such as inappropriate content, unsafe online interactions, and unmonitored communication with strangers.

This guide is designed to help parents understand:

- The specific safety concerns associated with Roblox (and briefly, Minecraft and Fortnite)
- How to set up and use parental controls
- How to talk with your child about online safety and responsible gaming
- Where to find trusted resources and setup guides

By staying informed and actively involved, parents can help ensure that online gaming remains a positive and secure experience for their children.

Recommended Age: 9+

According to ConnectSafely, players under 13 cannot access platform chat, and those under 9 are restricted to minimal or mild games unless a parent overrides the settings. While Roblox offers robust parental controls, including chat restrictions and spending limits, the platform's user-generated content and social features necessitate active supervision for younger players.

1. Why the Concern?

Recent reports have raised serious safety concerns about Roblox, including:

- Exposure to inappropriate or extreme content, such as hate speech or violent reenactments
- Child predation and grooming, with predators using Robux to lure children into unsafe chats or to move conversations to other apps (like Discord or Snapchat)
- Legal investigations involving adults posing as minors and exploiting children online

While Roblox has announced new safety measures — such as **ESRB rating labels** and **stricter age verification for chat features** — these will not be fully implemented until later in **2025**. In the meantime, **active parental monitoring** remains essential.

2. How You Can Protect Your Child

Set Up Roblox Parental Controls

Roblox offers built-in tools that help limit content and communication. You can:

- Link your parent account to your child's for shared management
- Choose **content maturity settings** (Minimal, Mild, or Moderate)
- Block specific games or experiences, regardless of maturity level
- Set screen time limits
- Adjust chat and communication settings ("No one" or "Friends only")
- Manage privacy and friend connections (who can see or message your child)
- Set **spending limits and purchase alerts** to prevent unauthorized Robux use
- Enable **two-step verification** for account security

Keep Talking and Monitoring

- **Discuss online safety** regularly. Encourage your child to tell you if someone says or does something that makes them uncomfortable.
- Review games together to understand what they're playing and why they enjoy it.
- Watch for changes in behavior irritability, secrecy, or distress after gaming can be signs something is off.

While Roblox, Minecraft, and Fortnite can be creative, social, and fun, they also open
doors to real online risks — including exposure to inappropriate content and potential
contact with unsafe individuals. Until full moderation and safety updates are in place,
the best protection is consistent supervision, active communication, and use of parental
controls.
