This initiative is specifically designed to support our local **Community** in Alabama. To qualify for the resources provided through Cotton's Adoption Boost Initiative, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- **Residency:** Must be a permanent resident of Alabama.
- **Location:** Must reside in one of the following counties: **Jefferson, Blount, Bibb, St. Clair, Shelby, Chilton, or Walker.**
- **Ownership:** Must be the legal owner (or potential legal owner) of the pet and be over 18 years of age.
