Solving the "History" Hurdle

Many adult dogs in shelters are "diamonds in the rough"—loving, loyal, and capable—but they lack the formal training that helps them shine in a home environment. The Foster to Train Initiative removes this barrier through a focused, expert-led process:

- **The 7-Day Intensive:** A professional trainer brings a shelter dog into their own home for an intensive one-week period. During this time, they establish foundational obedience like sitting, staying, and leash walking.
- **Tailored Care:** If a dog is found to have specialized behavioral needs, the training period is extended. We don't rush the process; we ensure the dog is truly "home-ready" before they move on.
- **A Certified Profile:** When the dog returns to the shelter, they come with a **Certified Training Profile**. This document provides total transparency, showing potential adopters exactly what the dog has mastered and what their personality is like in a home setting.

Lifetime Support for a Lifetime Bond

At Animal-Angels Foundation, our commitment to **Support** doesn't end when the adoption papers are signed. We want to ensure the transition is as stress-free as possible for both the pet and the owner.
