1. Copy of AKC, CKC, VDD, or NAVHDA registration document.
2. Copy of 3 generation pedigree.
3. Photo showing full side view of the dog. (Electronic image preferred)
4. Copy of field test scores and performance titles.
5. Copy of HD certification.
6. Copy of genetic disorders tests if applicable.
7. Copy of conformation rating if applicable.

Stud Dogs must conform to the breed standard. Height at withers: Dogs: 61 to 68 cm. Bitches: 57 to 64 cm.

To measure height: use a wicket or large slide rule and measure height at withers and ensure that dog does not crouch.

To measure length: measure from chest to rear just below the dog's tail.
