This isn't just about raising support—it's about **living out love, compassion, and action in your own community**, while helping sustain a home full of healing and hope in the Dominican Republic.

What's the purpose?

Nazareth House provides 24-hour care for children and youth with **physical and mental disabilities**—most of whom have been orphaned or abandoned. It costs **\$3,500 each month** to fund caregivers and teachers who provide love, learning, and dignity every day.

But your challenge also has a local side: it's an opportunity to inspire generosity, service, and connection where *you* live—by doing something that brings people together, uplifts others, and spreads kindness.

What makes this special?

This is more than a fundraiser—it's a movement.

2. How the Challenge Works

1. Form a Group

Gather friends, family, coworkers, or classmates to take on the challenge together.

Choose an activity that makes a positive impact—volunteer, serve, clean up, create, or care.

3. Set a Fundraising Goal

\$3,500 to cover one month of care for the children and young people at Nazareth House.

4. Invite Support

Ask others to sponsor your group's efforts—donations go directly to Nazareth House.

5. Make a Difference Near and Far

Celebrate the change you've made—both in your community and in the lives of those at Nazareth House.

Timeline or key dates

- 1. Our official challenge month is October—but the real goal is to bring your team together and make a lasting impact. Whether you take on the challenge in October or any time that works for you, what matters most is doing it together and making a difference. We suggest you give your team enough time to plan for your event, as well as to collect sponsorship. 2 months will give your team plenty of time organize.
- 2. To make the biggest impact, we recommend giving your team at least a month to prepare—time to dream up your activity, rally support, and fundraise with purpose!

Fundraising Goal

1. Group Fundraising Goal: Support One Month of Care - \$3,500

For your Go Make A Difference Challenge, we're inviting each group to set a bold, beautiful goal:

Raise \$3,500—enough to cover one full month of care at Nazareth House.

That one month provides:

- 24/7 care for children and young people with physical and mental disabilities
- Salaries for caregivers and teachers who give love, structure, and support every single day
- A home where every child is seen, safe, and surrounded by people who believe in them

Nazareth House is a sanctuary—but it only stays open with support. Your group can be part of keeping it going.

It might sound like a big number, but when you break it down, it's totally doable—and even fun—when you work as a team!

• \$3,500 ÷ 10 people = \$350 per person

Each person just needs to raise \$350, which could look like:

- Asking 10 friends to give \$35
- Sharing your story on social media and inviting people to support your cause

You don't need to do it all at once—and you're not doing it alone. When everyone pitches in with creativity, energy, and heart, reaching the goal becomes part of the adventure.

This is more than a fundraiser—it's a lifeline.

- On the donation form, they will see a section like:
 "Would you like your donation to support a specific fundraiser or team?"
- 3. From the **dropdown list**, they can choose:
 - o An individual fundraiser
 - A team (if team fundraising is enabled)
 - o Or leave it blank to donate to the general campaign
- 4. Continue with the donation process as normal.

Tips to Make This Easier:

- Ensure team and individual fundraisers are already created so they appear in the dropdown list.
- You can link directly to a team or individual fundraiser page, which will automatically assign the donation to them.
- Where does the money go?

Your donation to **Nazareth House** provides:

- Salaries for caregivers and teachers who offer 24-hour care
- Personal hygiene and medical supplies tailored to each child's needs

- Therapeutic support (e.g., physical therapy, basic equipment, educational tools)
- Nutritious meals and clean water for all residents
- o **Daily cleaning and maintenance** to ensure a safe, healthy environment
- Electricity and water services essential for round-the-clock care
 The monthly cost to keep Nazareth House running with full care staff is \$3,500 USD—and 100% of your donation goes directly to these essential needs.
