FIELD AGENT'S REPORT

Raising Awareness About Life Insurance

Each September since 2003 has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month. Like most awareness-raising campaigns, Life Insurance Awareness Month was created because there is an overwhelming lack of understanding of life insurance, its uses, its benefits, and its variations among the general public. Each year, the Life Insurance Market Research Association (LIMRA) puts out the results from a recent survey, and unfortunately, the numbers they report continue to be discouraging.

A recent survey found that more than 75 percent of people polled did not have a personal financial advisor, even though 68 percent of them said their opinion of the current economic conditions was somewhat unfavorable or very unfavorable. In other words, a majority of those surveyed were uncomfortable with the economy and the uncertainty it brings, yet they did not seek professional assistance. Maybe they spoke with their friends and family. Maybe they hoped the instability would go away on its own. Maybe they did not know to whom to turn.

If you fall into this category, please remember that as a member of the Knights of Columbus, you have a full-time, professional agent you can call your own. My primary responsibility is the care and service of your family's life insurance, retirement and long-term care needs. I'll answer your questions because I want your decisions to be informed ones. I want to help.

Another LIMRA statistic said 43 percent of people did not buy life insurance because they worry about "making the wrong decision." Talk with me, your agent, and, afterwards, you'll understand that the only wrong decision was not purchasing sooner to protect your family's future.

DEACON'S TEACHING By Deacon Chris Christopher

Why are Catholics Required to Attend Mass?

The powerful Babylonian empire conquered the people of ancient Judah, and nearly all of them were exiled from their land. The city of Jerusalem and the great temple within its gates were ruined. No longer able to worship there as their ancestors had done, the Jews were forced to live in a faraway pagan culture that knew nothing of their God.

Only many years later were the surviving exiles and their children allowed to return home at last. The books of Ezra and Nehemiah report what happened upon their arrival in Judah.

Not surprisingly, those who were serious about their faith made it their priority to rebuild the temple so they could worship there again. They wept and shouted with joy at its restoration. Having been deprived so long of the freedom to worship God as he had instructed them, they had learned to treasure their sacred assemblies in the house of the Lord (Ezr 3:1-13).

These ancient events illustrate why the Catholic Church requires attendance at Mass on Sundays and certain annual holy days. Worship is a primary duty owed to God by his creatures, which receive from him not only their very existence, but also every other good gift well. Worship is also a privilege, a precious opportunity to encounter the great King of the universe who loves his people beyond all telling.

The ancient Jews who recognized this awesome duty and privilege made every effort to go to the temple and offer their sacrifices of grain and animals. How much more, then, should Catholics be eager to attend Mass, where the glorious sacrifice of the Lamb of God himself is re-presented on the altar (Heb 9:13-14).

In the time of Moses, God had commanded his people "to keep holy the [weekly] Sabbath day" by setting it apart for worship and rest (Ex 20:8-11). The Church now applies what we might call that "Sabbath principle" to Sundays and holy days of obligation, when Mass attendance is an obligation.

Just as under the Old Covenant God required proper observance of the Sabbath, under the New Covenant the Church requires proper observance of Sunday, "the Lord's day" (Rv 1:10), the day of Resurrection. In fact, among the formal "precepts" (rules) of the Church, this one is the very first.

We must keep in mind that the Church has an obligation to guide its flock. With the authority extended to it by Jesus, it has set minimums (not maximums) for the faithful in maintaining their faith. Attending Mass regularly is one of those disciplines designed to aid us in keeping our faith alive.

Blackwater Pyrates Annual Blessing of the Fleet Saturday 20 May

The Blackwater Pyrates in conjunction with The Knights of Columbus of Milton, are sponsoring a **Blessing of the Fleet** that will take place at the Memorial Park Boardwalk in downtown Milton on <u>Saturday 20 May</u> at 1:00 pm.

Vessels for the **Blessing** - all watercraft whether a motor, man or wind powered should circle in front of the Milton Memorial Park boardwalk until the Blackwater Pyrate lead boat begins the slow, single file pass-by for individual blessings. Bagpipers and 4th Degree Knights of Columbus in regalia will accompany Msgr. Michael Reed on the boardwalk for the **Blessing**.

Blackwater Pyrates Annual Free Vessel Examination Day Saturday 20 May.

Whether your vessel is motor, wind or man powered, the Blackwater Pyrates - in conjunction with the US Coast Guard Auxiliary – is sponsoring a free water vessel examination day on <u>Saturday 20 May</u> from 9 am to 12 pm at *Carpenter's Park* and *Russell Harbor* boat landings in Milton.

Vessels passing the inspection will receive a sticker for the vessel acknowledging the pass. As this is **not** a law enforcement inspection, vessels not passing will be given a checklist of deficiencies, but **not** a citation. Within reason, deficiencies will be corrected free of charge by the Auxiliary and Blackwater Pyrates on the spot.

The Feast of Mercy, Divine Mercy Sunday



"And who knows anything about this feast? No one!"

That's what our Lord said to St. Faustina about Divine Mercy Sunday, which this year is April 23rd. In St. Faustina's *Diary, Divine Mercy in My Soul*, this conversation between St. Faustina and Jesus Christ is recorded (with St. Faustina's words in regular type, and Our Lord's words in boldface):

I am very surprised that You bid me to talk about this Feast of Mercy, for they tell me that there is already such a feast and so why should I talk about it? And Jesus said to me, **And who knows anything about this feast? No one! Even those who should be proclaiming My mercy and teaching people about it often do not know about it themselves. That is why I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it (***Diary*, 341).

According to the *Diary* of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, Jesus Christ made a special promise, which she was to communicate to the whole world:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy (*Diary*, 699).

In three places in her *Diary*, St. Faustina records a promise from our Lord of specific, extraordinary graces He will make available through the devout reception of Holy Communion on this Feast Day; truly a "whole ocean of graces" is contained in these promises:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109).

Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (300).

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (699).
