DEACON'S TEACHING By Deacon Chris Christopher

Why Does the Church Contain So Many Sinners?



When Ezra the priest led his people in confession of their sins as a nation, the resulting list of wrongdoing was extensive: idolatry, rebellion, disobedience, pride, ingratitude, stubbornness, murder, injustice, and more. Again and again, God extended them mercy; again and again, they slid back into sin. If God hadn't been longsuffering, the people would have perished many times over (Neh 91-37).

Today, God's people receive bountiful graces through our Lord Jesus Christ that weren't available in Ezra's time. Most importantly, we have the sacraments of the Church to make us holy. Yet even though such sacraments as Baptism and Reconciliation cleanse us of sin, we are still left with "concupiscence" – a certain weakness of the soul that inclines us to sin, so that the road to holiness is a continual struggle.

Consequently, Scripture confirms that the Church is composed not just of saints in the making, but also sinners. We see this reality most indisputably in certain parables of Jesus about the kingdom of heaven – the Church. In the parable of the wheat and the weeds, for example, Jesus teaches that both will grow together until harvest time, the final judgment (Mat 13:24-30; compare Mt 3:12). He also compares the Church to a fishnet that draws good and bad fish, which must be separated, but not until the end (Mt 13:47-50). From the very beginning, the Church has been a mixed bag: Even the thief and traitor Judas was one of the apostles, chosen by Jesus himself (Mt 10:1, 4; Mk 3:14; Jn 6:70-71; Acts 1:17).

Since we too are sinners, we must not let the presence of other sinners in the Church scandalize us. The good news is that God's mercy in Christ is extended to those whose sins disturb us most (Rom 2:1-8; 5:8, 19-21). In the meantime, only God knows who will finally end up as "wheat" and who as "weeds." We must leave it to him to sort us out (Mt 13:28-30).

Blessing of the Fleet 0n May 20, 2017

The Saint Teresa of Calcutta Assembly 2823 will be sponsoring a **Blessing** of the Fleet at the Memorial Park Boardwalk in downtown Milton on Saturday 20 May at 1:00 pm.

All watercraft, whether motor, wind, or man powered, should circle in front of the Milton Memorial Park Boardwalk until the lead boat begins the slow, single file pass-by for individual blessings. Bagpipers and 4th Degree Knights of Columbus in regalia will accompany Msgr. Michael Reed on the boardwalk for the blessing.

Free Coast Guard Auxiliary Vessel Examination

In conjunction with National Boating Safety Week, the Coast Guard Auxiliary will be holding its annual, free Vessel Examination - whether motor, wind, or man powered - on <u>Saturday 20 May</u> from 9am to 12pm at *Carpenter's Park* and *Russell Harbor* boat landings in Milton.

Vessels passing the inspection will receive a sticker for the vessel acknowledging the pass. As this **not** a law enforcement inspection, vessels not passing the inspection will be given a checklist of deficiencies, but **not** a citation. The Coast Guard and Blackwater Pyrates will provide free correction-of-deficiencies, within reason, on the spot.

College Scholarship Opportunity for St. Rose High School Seniors
