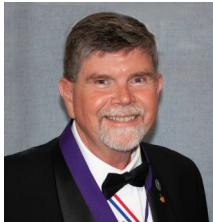

Dear Brother Knights and Families,

Our **Worthy Deputy Grand Knight Dan Arndt** and I attended the **118th Annual Florida State Council Convention** in Orlando May 13-15. We represented our council as delegates to conduct state council business. It was good to be with our brother knights from all over Florida and The Bahamas face to face once again. And it was inspiring to hear about all the great works being accomplished in our order's name.

As part of the state council business, our own **Past Grand Knight (and District Deputy) Cesar Mascardo** was elected as an alternate delegate to the Supreme Convention in Nashville. In the event the delegate is unable to attend, Brother Cesar will be one of the representatives from the Florida State Council when Supreme Council conducts its business this summer.

Our Council was recognized at the convention for **Pregnancy Center Support** at the Bronze level. Thank you for all you do to support centers such as Life Options and the Majella House.

Also announced at the convention, the **2022-23 Charity Raffle** is underway, and it's an easy fundraiser for our council. For each ticket we sell, we turn in half the money and our council keeps the other half. Currently, our council has only 200 tickets at \$5 each. If we sell all 200 tickets, our council earns \$500. Think about that...we have less tickets to sell than we have members in our council, and we can offer the tickets to anyone – knights, family members, parishioners, co-workers, anyone! The Grand Prize is \$25,000, Second Prize is \$15,000, and three Third Prizes are \$5,000 each!

Join us on Friday, June 3, at 6:30 PM CDT for an informative webinar as the Knights of Columbus hosts "**Retirement Planning in a Changing Landscape**," featuring America's IRA Expert Ed Slott. And remember, if you can't join us live, it will be available on-demand afterwards. Our Field Agent, Jeff Fischer, has registered us for a watch party where we can watch as a group. The June 9 meeting is especially important because we'll conduct our election of officers for the new fraternal year that starts on July 1. Deacon's Teaching

Easter Tide

The Feast of Pentecost commemorates the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Church as it was poured out on the disciples in Jerusalem after the resurrection of Jesus. It is referred to as the birthday of the Church because from that point on the apostles carried the message of Christ to the whole world and ushered in a new era for the people of God. It is that same Holy Spirit that we receive through the rites of initiation in baptism and confirmation. The mission of those first disciples was to spread the Good News of Jesus to the ends of the earth. That is also our mission.

To get a fuller understanding of who God is, one needs to understand **all** of whom God is. Knowing the difference between God the Father and Jesus Christ is one thing, but many struggle to grasp who or what the Holy Spirit is and His role in our lives, hence, the importance of the Feast of Pentecost.

God is one but He has three natures: God The Father, God The Son, and God The Holy Spirit. This may be bad math, but it's good theology. This three-in-oneness of God is referred to as The Trinity, all of whom are equal. The Holy Spirit, therefore, is co-eternal with The Father and The Son. Scripture tells us that the Holy Spirit existed right from the beginning, *"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters."* (Genesis 1:1-2)

Like God The Father and God The Son, The Holy Spirit is not an influence but a distinct personality. As a person He can be grieved. St. Paul tells us, *"And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with*

whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." (Ephesians 4:30)

Understanding who the Holy Spirit is, the place He holds within the Trinity, and the role He plays in our lives, is vital to anyone in search of what it means to become a better Christian. The Holy Spirit cares about believers in Christ and responds to them. He knows the Father's thoughts and communicates those thoughts to them. For example, when we pray or read the Bible and sense God speaking to us, it is the Holy Spirit at work in our life. The more we let this sink in, the easier it will be to give the Holy Spirit the place of authority He deserves in our lives.

Jesus left us the sacraments through which the Holy Spirit conveys the grace of God in a physical and tangible way. Pentecost marks the beginning of this new, sacramental era in which we live today. It does so because the ministers of the sacraments (usually priests and deacons) effect the sacraments because the Holy Spirit acts through them.

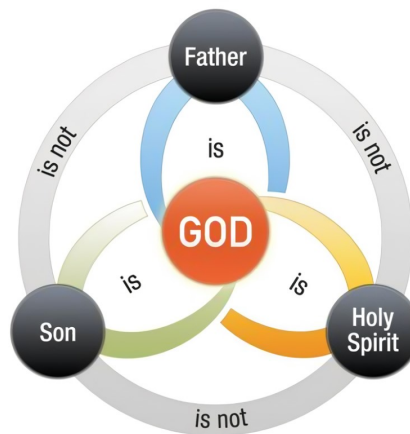
Jesus told us he had to leave this earth so that the paraclete/advocate/counselor could come to guide us and be with us just as He had; that person is the Holy Spirit (Gospel of John 14:16, 14:26, 15:26, 16:7, and First Epistle of John chapter 2, verse 1), and He continues to guide the Church today. As St. Augustine said, the Holy Spirit is the soul of the Church, and as the soul gives life to the body, so also the Spirit gives life to the Church.

St. Paul lists the fruits of the Spirit in his Letter to the Galatians *"What the Spirit brings is ... love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control"* (5:22).

He continues, "Since the Spirit is our life, let us be directed by the Spirit"^(5:25). St. Paul insists that these spiritual gifts are to be used in the present time for the benefit of others, for the common good, and for the building up of the body of Christ. And in doing so, we also become beneficiaries of those same gifts.

Faith = RSVP, Into the breach, Rosary, Holy hour, spiritual reflection and sacramental gifts.

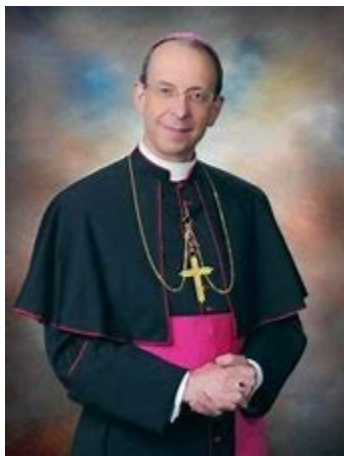
Family = Food for families, Family of the month, keep Christ in Christmas, family fully alive, consecration to the holy family, family week and more.

Announcement of the Annual Columbia Club of Milton, Inc. (CCMI) General Membership Meeting

The annual meeting of the CCMI general membership is scheduled for the 9th of June, 2022 immediately following the KofC council 7027 business meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to elect corporate board of directors to fill vacating positions and to approve the previously proposed by-law changes.

The board of directors puts forth a proposed slate of candidates for your consideration. Nominations will be taken from the floor as well. The proposed slate:
President; Brian McGuire
Vice President; Adam Rapach
Secretary; Rusty Bradberry (second term)
Treasurer; Ron Livorno
Member-at-large; Sid Roussell (second term)
Member-at-large; Cesar Mascardo

Proposed significant changes to the by-laws are presented below for membership review to be voted on at the annual general membership meeting. For a more comprehensive view of proposed changes please visit the Council 7027 website (www.kofc7027.com) in the document section of the member only part, the proposed changes are in **bold red**.

Article VI, Section 2a: Delete last sentence of (a) which reads: "A quorum for the Annual Meeting shall be (15%) of the membership , and not less than 35 members. **Rational:** A quorum as presently described is rarely met if ever. A "majority vote" as stated in the first sentence of (a) should stand.

2b: To read: " The term of an elected Director shall be for three years. One and two year terms may be utilized at the discretion of the Board to ensure continuity of corporate knowledge". **Rational:** As it stands.

2c: Sentence added: "A Board member may not serve more than two consecutive terms". **Rational:** As it stands.

Article VI, Section 5a: Change "The Board shall meet monthly" to "at a minimum of once a quarter". **Rational:** Why meet if there is no business. A special meeting can be called at any time as specified in Article VI, Section 5b.

Article VIII, Section 2: Sentence added "Should the President and Vice President be unavailable the Secretary may be authorized to sign if the issuance of a check is of an urgent nature. **Rational:** Check issuance requires 2 signatures, usually the treasurer and one other. This change allows for all board officers to have signing authority. Experience as shown that more than one Board Officer may not be available when a check issuance is needed.

Article XI, Section 2: Financial audit is changed from twice a year to at the least every 18 months and at the end of the Treasurer's term. **Rational:** Accounting is straight forward and is not complicated to follow using "Quick Books". Only a few transactions are conducted each month and are repeated with the exception of tax related and insurance expenses.
