## Deacon's Teaching

What are Indulgences?

The basis of Indulgences is not *Forgiveness* but *Restitution*. That is, God

forgives but requires temporal restitution for sin. ([See: Adam & Eve, Forgiveness but banishment from The Garden and toil (Genesis 3); King David and Bathsheba (2 Samuel 11:1ff); King David after taking his census (2 Samuel 24:10ff); King Ahab of Israel (1 Kings 21:1-29)).

Although we confess an actual sin, we are only forgiven **that** sin. We can still harbor the **root cause of that** sin. "You, therefore, must be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect" [because] 'Nothing unclean will enter [heaven].' (See: Matthew 5:48; Matthew 12:32; Luke (12:59) 1 Corinthians 3:13-15; Rev 21:27).


Since being perfect is hard to achieve, what happens to us upon death? "Those who die in God's grace and friendship imperfectly purified, although they are assured of their eternal salvation, undergo a purification after death, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of God." (CCC 1054)

Temporal restitution for the root cause of our sins can be made in this life through sacrifices, offered-up-sufferings, prayer, acts of charity, time spent in Adoration, etc., or the next life - purgatory.


Through the power of "binding and loosing" (Mt 18:18; Jn 20:23), the Church offers Indulgences on our behalf for the "remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven" (CCC 1471). Thus, an Indulgence removes all or part of the temporal punishment due to sins <u>up to that point in life</u>. After gaining an Indulgence, our temporal punishment 'clock' restarts.

Therefore, under the 'usual conditions,' temporal restitution can be made for sins through an Indulgence.

#### **Supreme Chaplain's Challenge** by Archbishop William E. Lori

And he asked them, "But who do Challenge by Supreme you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Messiah." (Gospel for Sept. 15, Mk 8:29)

## **Chaplain Archbishop William** E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to make Peter's profession of faith — "You are the Messiah" — a frequent aspiration, or short prayer, you recite throughout each day, perhaps writing it down some place you will see it regularly to remind yourself.

Peter was the first of the apostles to openly profess Jesus as the awaited Messiah, the Christ or anointed one. Today, every Christian is called to proclaim in word and deed that Jesus is the Christ. We must never lose the awe and wonder of recognizing Jesus as the Messiah and Savior, especially when we encounter him in the sacrament of penance and in the Mass.

### Questions for Reflection:

When you say the name of Jesus Christ, are you mindful of what this truly means? When you approach a priest for confession, are you fully cognizant that the absolution you receive through the priest comes from Christ himself? When you approach holy Communion, do you recognize and contemplate Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist you receive?




