

FAIR DEMOLITION DERBY RULES & REGULATIONS - 2023
POWER WHEELS

BUILD:

- Children up to 10-years old may participate, if they fit safely into the vehicle without modifications.
- Only a single battery permitted. It can be positioned anywhere inside the vehicle, as long as the battery is secure and the driver is protected.
- Secure the doors and hood so they do not come open during the race with a bungee, strap or similar method.
- Seatbelts are not mandatory but are recommended.
- Helmets are mandatory.
- Screws or rubber may be added to the tires for traction.
- No sharp or pointed objects permitted anywhere on the exterior/interior of the vehicle.
- Homemade bumpers permitted. Again, no sharp or pointed objects. Anything determined to be a safety concern will be removed.

RACE:

- Event formats will vary.
 - Balloon Derby – Each vehicle is fitted with balloons. Once all balloons are popped or fall off a vehicle, the driver is disqualified. Last driver with a balloon will win.
 - Timed Derby – Drivers will run into each other for approximately 10 minutes. After the 10 minutes, the remaining vehicles will be lined up and drag race or obstacle race to determine the winner.
- This is for fun. Be safe. Awards will be typically be provided to the top three finishers.
