3-man team heats will be held on Saturday. Conciliation and Feature on Sunday. "Other Classes" will run on Sunday.

3-Man Team Format (80's & FWD Windshield):

- Heats will be 1 team VS 1 team. Match-up will be by luck of draw. Winning team advances.
- Losing teams can enter consolation heat. Each team will send ONE car for consolation heat. Last (2 or 3) cars running, and their entire teams will advance to feature.
- No welding, No patching, No fix-it-plates between Heats, Conci and Feature. Welding is limited
 to remounting bumpers, frame tears and repairing suspension. Any welding MUST BE
 APPROVED by the designated team class official/inspector. A <u>limited</u> amount of 9-wire will be
 permitted after heats, where frames are damaged/bent.
- Team cars must pass inspection by 4:30 p.m. on Saturday. No working on cars after inspection. Heat winners will be impounded until 7 a.m. on Sunday. Vehicles may not leave property for repairs.
- Pin-To-Win applies in the heats and feature. Two cars of the same team can pin the last opposing car.
- The CAR qualifies for the feature. May not substitute another car onto a team after the event has started.
- Incomplete teams may switch drivers, cars or combine to make a full team. Must be done by the end of the drivers meeting.
- In the event of an odd number of teams show up, one team will be given a bye into the feature. The bye will be drawn by random. The first five teams to completely pass inspection will be entered into the bye draw. Also, if a team only has two cars, this team may also be entered into the bye draw. If a team only has 1 car, that team will automatically get the bye.
- All feature cars will be re-inspected. This re-inspection will be performed at the pits. Each team
 class will have a designated inspector which will be roaming the pits on Sunday. Once reinspected, the feature cars will report to the horse track for staging.
- WARNING if a car is caught cheating with a loaded or plated frame/body outside of what is specified in the rules, that car will automatically be disqualified from the event.
