PROGRAMS

Canskate (Learn to Skate) is a dynamic, learn-to skate program that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development. Based on Sport Canada's long-term centers on physical literacy and the fundamentals needed to take part in any ice sport or to skate as a recreational activity.

This program is led by NCCP-trained professional coaches and assisted by trained assistants.

You can expect Action, Movement and Fun in this program! Lessons are delivered in a group format.

A CSA approved hockey helmet, long pants, mittens, warm sweater/jacket and skates are required for this program.

Baltimore FSC has attained 'Exceeded Standard' for Skate Ontario's CanSkate Excellence Recognition Program.

CanSkate – Parent & Tot can be used as option for skaters who require hand-on assistance getting up and maneuvering on the ice. Parent will be responsible for assisting their skater. All participants on a Parent & Tot session must be registered with Skate Canada.

A CSA approved hockey helmet, long pants, mittens, warm sweater/jacket and skates are required for this program. Parent must wear a CSA approved helmet if their own skating ability level is below Stage 5.

Pre-StarSkate - a program for skaters who have successfully completed their Stage 3 CanSkate badge, and who are interested in moving towards entering Skate Canada StarSkate Program. CSA approved helmets must be worn until your child has completed Stage 5 (as per Skate Canada).

StarSkate – offers opportunities for skaters of all ages to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, freeskate and interpretive skating. Skaters have the opportunity to take Skate Canada tests through a nationally standardized testing system. Private Coaching is required for individual lessons and should be arranged with the Coaching staff prior to the start of the season. Please be sure to discuss all formats of lessons with your Coach (private, semi private and group).

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION FEE - To participate in the Skate Canada programs, all skaters must be a member of Skate Canada. The \$60 fee is payable at time of registration and will be remitted by the club to Skate Canada.

FAMILY DISCOUNT – If you have more than one skater registered full time in our skating programs, the first skater will pay the set registration fee and each additional skater will receive a \$25 discount at the lowest club level.

A FEE OF \$30 WILL BE CHARGED ON ALL NSF OR RETURNED CHEQUES.

Due to limited coaching resources, and in order to ensure a good learning experience for all skaters, children age 3 and under may undergo a skating assessment to ensure they are ready to enter the program. If the Coaches feel that it is too early for your child to enter the program, the club will issue you a full refund, with the exception of the \$60.
