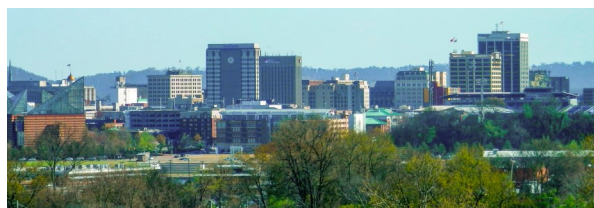
Dear Friends!
